This paper starts from the concept of immersive media and augmented reality technology, expounds the close relationship between augmented reality and interactive design, analyzes the outstanding cases on the market, and summarizes principles of interactive experience design for AR application, which are based on user needs, coexistence of professionalism and interest, realistic information and natural interface design, and enhancement of multi-sensory immersive experience, as well as the design direction that needs to be paid attention to, so as to provide ideas for design practice.

## 1. AR TECHNOLOGY AND APPLICATION

Nowadays, with the development of the digital age, the virtual world produced by computer network has made profound changes in people's outlook, behavior, and life style. Augmented reality (AR) is a technology that can seamlessly mix the real world and the virtual world in real time and provide users with a better sense of immersion and reality [1]. Augmented reality technology simply refers to the technology that combines the real world with virtual experience [2].

AR research began in 1968. Ivan Sutherland, father of computer graphics and virtual reality, introduced augmented reality system into the research of head mounted display. In 1990, Boeing researcher Tom Caudell first used "augmented reality" in his paper. It is widely recognized in the research of augmented reality that Ronald Azuma in 1997 combined the concept of augmented reality with real world elements and virtual images to realize real-time interaction existing in three-dimensional space. Then Ronald Azuma defined three characteristics of AR. Firstly, the existence of real-world elements must exist without time or virtual world image errors. Secondly, the virtual image or object must be reflected in the real world in 3D form. Thirdly, the real-time interaction with users' needs to be smooth [3].

Generally, AR is a concept existing between the real world and the virtual world. It is a technology originated from the field of virtual reality. It mixes real and virtual information together to interact with users, and goes

beyond the content that can be experienced in a limited way in the real world. As the user's perceiving psychology and corresponding effect in the process of visual informative interaction with augmented reality technology enhance the user's sense of immersion and existence, the application based on AR can enhance the user's sense of experience, to achieve business goals and social innovation.

## 2. AR AND INTERACTIVE EXPERIENCE DESIGN

The key to the application of AR technology is how to improve the interaction design of user's good experience. The concept of interaction design was formally proposed and set up as an independent discipline in the 1980s. The initial interaction design focused more on the interactive process and behavioral system between people and the computer, which was closely related to ergonomics, user psychology and other disciplines. Its research and application in industrial design, screen-based design of computer application and UI design (user interface design) are relatively more mature and perfect. As a research category focusing on user interactive experience, interaction design was proposed in 1984 by Bill Moggridge, one of the founders of IDEO. In his book *Designing Interactions*, however, the expression of interaction design had not been extended to VR / AR, and more still stayed on game design, web design, screen interface design and interactive experience. *Three-Dimensional User Interface: Theory and Practice*, written by Bauman et al., discusses three-dimensional interactive interface in space from three-dimensional user experience, design, and evaluation. However, with the increasing demand for interactive experience, immersive AR with immersive, interactive, and imaginative multi-sensory experience has been brought into the field of interaction design.

## 3. AR AND INTERACTIVE EXPERIENCE DESIGN

AR includes AR hardware system, AR software system and AR application content.

Especially in the AR application content, the user experience will be different from the original two-dimensional content, and the differentiated design

strategy of content design must be established accordingly. Therefore, it is necessary to design and research the user experience to improve the user satisfaction of AR application, to enhance the user stickiness, and then achieve the goal of commercial purpose and social innovation. We study and analyze in the field of AR application content. At present, AR application has penetrated various fields, and rapidly integrated into all aspects of life and work with the increasingly mature technology. According to the types of augmented reality content, it can be divided into four areas: marketing and advertising, entertainment, education, art, and culture.

### 3.1 Marketing and advertising

Augmented reality (AR) advertising provides the sympathetic experience of 3D images, so users (consumers) can interact in real time to immerse themselves in advertising naturally.

The popularity of interactive marketing is increasing in the field of marketing and advertising, which because of the need for a method of inducing voluntary visits from the public rather than simply providing a medium for product information. Consumers can feel the interest and immerse themselves in it at the same time, and have a positive impression and evaluation of the company's brand or product. For example, Chengdu Renhe department store "commercial art and interactive image" is an excellent AR shopping space design case, which is a work combining interactive images and an Augmented reality for Renhe new city in Chengdu. Renhe Zoo uses live AR technology to present interactive content with animals-themed, gorgeous colors and different textures. It adds photography to the story of the content, so that visitors can actively participate in and enjoy the image content. And it also guides naturally the video and image sharing online.

### 3.2 Entertainment

In the field of entertainment, AR game applications occupy the largest mode. The most famous case is Nintendo's "Pokemon Go" augmented reality game launched in 2016, which provide a way for the public to experience augmented reality. Compared to other games, Pokemon forces you to walk out of your house and your comfort zone. You must be physically and mentally active; you need to find and capture virtual monsters in the real world and go where the Pokemon stays to get more information and catch objects, and finally find strategies for making stronger Pokemon and reaching higher levels. "Pokemon go" has become one of the most downloaded mobile apps in the world. It is one of the most downloaded games in more than 27 countries (more than 100 million), and one of the highest user retention rates among all mobile game applications.

The most important elements of augmented reality in the field of entertainment are direct "experience" and intuitive "experience". Through the application of augmented reality and the reality reflected in mobile phone, it is used as augmented reality game space, which brings rich experience at the same time. In fact, mobile phone AR mobile game is a form that users can

participate in and enjoy. Its core is to use the sensor of camera in mobile phone, which can realize all kinds of information and fun through object or position recognition. Users can experience and use it, and can directly interact with the screen in the field. But it is worth noting that the design of AR content needs to be developed according to people's cognitive ability and senses.

### 3.3 Education

Augmented reality education application is an application of direct participation in education methods, which can see, hear, touch, and learn various types of knowledge content, and can carry out experience-based learning through perception and immersion and direct interaction. Traditional education is inseparable from books, and augmented reality education applications can also be perfectly combined with books, such as tagme3D. It is a book application dedicated to helping non-native English children learn to speak English. It is composed of 4 books and 400 words, including basic spelling and natural spelling materials that should be learned before kindergarten. After scanning the picture in AR mode, the 3D version of the image will be displayed. The image will teach the children to pronounce and spell the corresponding words. For example, when learning the word tiger, the app will scan the tiger image in the book and mobile 3D tiger image will jump out of the book. "Tiger, this is a tiger" will be read at the same time. Books designed with AR technology are more vivid and interesting, and can stimulate the interest and motivation of learning.

### 3.4 Art and culture

Augmented reality is the most widely used in the field of art and culture. For example, in 2020, Huawei and Dunhuang Institute jointly launched the "Dunhuang super perception image". With the help of Huawei P40 series mobile phones as the media, the virtual image of nine color deer is realized through the super perception image function, and a mysterious world of interaction between virtual and reality is created which combined the real Dunhuang Mogao Grottoes scene. Huawei River map mainly uses centimeter level space identification technology to rebuild a virtual Mogao Grottoes space which is the same as the real scene. With the power of science and technology, Dunhuang has extended from the dark Grottoes to the infinite digital space. Its AR interactive experience allows users to enter Dunhuang Grottoes for immersive visit. With the popularity and application of 5G, tourists can experience the effect of AR digital content which is clearer and more realistical in the process of sightseeing, and can have a real three-dimensional immersion experience.

## 4. DESIGNING PRINCIPLES OF AR APPLICATION INTERACTIVE EXPERIENCE

### 4.1 Based on users' needs, with both professionalism and amusement

AR application can render virtual digital information in real-time environment, and help users complete a task and activity by combining reality and virtual. Therefore, in the process of AR application content design, we



should fully recognize the core role of user requirements and insist on the user-centered design and development. It is worth noting that AR technology is only a method and method to solve problems. Designers should use technology to show the ability of design to solve problems, and technology cannot be equal to content. For example, Tagme 3D application is to fully cater for the user's needs. Tagme 3D user group is a group of children who need to learn English and their native language is not English. So, in AR application content design, cartoon virtual image and English pronunciation are used to close with users, and then users can quickly accept the information they want to learn to achieve the purpose of learning language.

For the design of AR application content, we should consider the specialty and interest. For example, the Dunhuang super perception image mentioned above shows the complete professional Mogao Grottoes information to users by AR technology. The sensory experience of virtual and realistic intersection has strong interest.

#### 4.2 Realistic information and natural interface design

AR application has gradually become the developing trend of computing equipment. Immersive AR technology can break the cognitive barrier between man and machine, and help people interact with the digital world in a more natural way. Materialized information is to present some virtual information or instructions directly on the relevant real scene, which is convenient for users to understand and operate. For example, the game application Pokemon Go is to make full use of realistic information for design, and interact with virtual game information and cartoon images in real scenes. Natural interface design is a kind of human-computer interaction mode which is more suitable for human needs and preferences, and users can be more natural and closer to the real behavior. In the interaction mode, it is mainly about "voice, gesture, and touch". The natural interface design can minimize cognitive friction, to reduce the distraction when doing tasks, and achieve the goal more efficiently. Therefore, AR application design should pay attention to the design of realistic information and natural interface.

4.3 Enhancement of multi-sensory immersive experience  
In order to provide users with more comprehensive

information and all-round experience, and create multiple narrative aesthetic feeling, general AR applications try to mobilize users' multiple senses to operate together.

First, an excellent AR application should have a friendly interface, and the operation mode and interactive gesture should conform to the user's natural cognition and operating habits. For example, in the case of Renhe Zoo, it is a familiar way to make AR applications interact with users by means of taking photos. Secondly, we should prevent excessive use of AR technology to attract users' attention to avoid reaction. The presentation mode should not be too single. Combined with various means of collaborative display, we can reduce users' cognitive load and sensory quality decline caused by the mode of information presentation. In the process of user operation, it can give real-time feedback on hearing or touch, and establish the intimate relationship between virtual objects and users.

#### 5. CONCLUSION

In recent years, augmented reality technology can make modern people's life more convenient. It makes full use of our human senses, provides virtual information as the real world, and removes the real information technology. In the immersion experience, it opens the vision of people's extensive use and changes people's way of life and behavior. However, in the theoretical research of augmented reality, more emphasis is placed on the technical level. But with the stability of technology, novelty has been unable to meet people's needs. The application of sensory design, cognitive design and physical interaction design is the research focus of AR application in the future, and more scholars are expected to participate in this research.

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# Network Public Opinion Governance of Public Health Emergencies in the New Media Age: A Case Study of the Changsheng Problem Vaccine Incident

**Abstract:** To analyze the governance of network public opinion in the event of the Changsheng Problem Vaccine, and to provide reference for the government and relevant departments to better guide and respond to the network public opinion of vaccine-related public health emergencies. Using Sina micro-hotspot system and taking national netizens as the research object, this paper collects relevant data of the time span from July 15th to July 29th, 2018, and analyses the public opinion governance of the Changsheng Problem Vaccine Incident from four aspects: the evolution trend of network public opinion, the media dissemination of public opinion, public opinion attitude and government public opinion response. The trend of the volume of the Changsheng Problem Vaccine Incident is basically consistent with the evolution of the public health events. Emerging social media has become the main platform for discussion of related topics, and Weibo has become the main medium for public opinion communication. The public is an important force in the development of network public opinion. Negative emotions such as anger and panic are prone to distrust. The government's positive and effective response can effectively enhance public confidence and stabilize emotions. The governance strategy of network public opinion in public health emergencies should enhance the crisis public relations ability of the involved subjects, improve the supervision mechanism and system construction of the government and relevant departments, strengthen media self-discipline, and play the role of opinion leaders in public opinion communication, and increase public health Knowledge to guide rational behavior.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

In recent years, China's public health emergencies occur frequently, which has attracted the attention of the government and relevant departments. In particular, the occurrence of a series of problem vaccine events has aroused great concern of the society and become a hot spot of public opinion. The network public opinion of public health emergencies refers to the Internet public opinion that Internet users take the Internet as the

communication platform and take public health events as the topic. In today's all media era, network media has become the main channel for the public to obtain information. [1] Once the problem vaccine incident was reported, the relevant information spread rapidly on the Internet, causing public panic, causing overreaction, and threatening social stability.

The longevity vaccine event has the dual characteristics of public health and network public opinion. Vaccine incident is a kind of public health emergency, which is related to the life and health of children vaccinated. In the context of risk society, the combination of public health emergencies with the characteristics of instant and rapid dissemination of social media information is particularly easy to trigger online public opinion, generate Internet rumors, and cause public opinion panic, which needs to be attached great importance. [2] Therefore, this study takes the "longevity problem vaccine" event as an example to analyze the evolution trend of network public opinion, the dissemination of public opinion, the public information demand and the government public opinion response in the vaccine event, so as to provide reference for the network public opinion governance of similar vaccine related public health emergencies in the future.

## 2. DATA AND METHODS

### 2.1 Event overview

On July 15, 2018, the State Food and Drug Administration (SFDA) issued a notice that Changchun Changsheng had made false records in the production of freeze-dried rabies vaccine for human use, and the problem vaccines were exposed in succession, causing public concern about children's health. Changchun Changsheng launched the self-examination procedure, implemented the recall of the problem vaccine, and issued a statement, but it did not calm down the public heated discussion. On the 18th, the public was strongly dissatisfied with the amount of tickets issued by the Jilin provincial drug administration. On July 21, an article named "king of vaccines" quickly became popular in wechat circle of friends. This article pushed the issue of vaccine safety to the top of the storm. After many days of fermentation, the network public opinion on the vaccine event of longevity problem was completely detonated. On the 29 day, the Public Security Bureau drew the relevant suspect to the arrest. So far, the vaccine counterfeiting

event has triggered public discussion on vaccine safety, vaccine supervision and other topics. According to the statistics of sina micro hotspot big data platform, as of 24:00 on July 29, 2018, the amount of information related to the longevity problem vaccine event in the whole network reached 5668140, and the heat index was 64.04%.

## 2.2 Research methods

At present, Sina micro hotspot analysis system has been familiar with and widely used in the big data environment, with high influence and credibility. In this study, Sina micro hotspot system was used to collect the public opinion data of the "longevity problem vaccine" event from July 15 to July 29, 2018, taking out netizens nationwide as the research object, and sorting out and analyzing the evolution trend of online public opinion, network public opinion dissemination, public opinion attitude and government public opinion response, and put forward the public health emergency The strategy of event network public opinion governance.

## 3. RESULT ANALYSIS

### 3.1 Analysis on the evolution of network public opinion on the longevity vaccine event

From the change trend of the event volume (see Figure 1), the evolution trend of the network public opinion of the longevity problem vaccine event experienced four stages: the precursor period, the outbreak period, the fluctuation period and the fading period.

**3.1.1 Precursory period (July 15-july 20, 2018):** during which the public opinion volume continued to grow. On July 15, the State Food and Drug Administration informed Changsheng biological subsidiary Changchun Changsheng rabies vaccine production record fraud. Since then, public opinion on the problem vaccine broke

out one after another, triggering a "national" hot debate. Later, Changchun Changsheng responded one after another, trying to eliminate public opinion panic by "recalling" and "the vaccine has not yet been delivered". However, things went against our wishes. The incident continued to ferment and the volume of voice continued to rise. Due to the failure of enterprise self-examination to calm public opinion, and another vaccine of Changchun Changsheng was found to be unqualified, the volume of vaccine incident rose again from the 20th.

**3.1.2 Outbreak period (July 21-july 23, 2018):** on the 21st, the voice volume of public opinion began to rise sharply, and on the 23rd, the volume reached the peak (1526664), representing the highest concern of the public opinion. On the 21 day, a WeChat official account entitled "vaccine king" spread rapidly, becoming an article on social media screen, which made public opinion more rapid. The article and its derivative topics broke out in a short period of time, and the problem vaccine caused hot public discussion, with the highest public opinion on the 23rd.

**3.1.3 Fluctuation period (July 24-29, 2018):** compared with the previous period, the volume of public opinion shows a downward trend, with occasional low amplitude fluctuations. On the 22nd and 23rd, the truth was found out about the vaccine incident, and the public's negative emotions were controlled to a certain extent. After that, the volume of public opinion continued to decline.

**3.1.4 Dissipation period (after July 29, 2018):** the volume of public opinion remains low. After the publication of the investigation results, the response to the questions about the vaccine, the control and punishment of the people involved, etc., the incident was calmed down. Internet public opinion is gradually falling back.

### 3.2 Analysis on the network public opinion transmission of longevity vaccine event

The micro hotspot system was used to make statistics on the media that released the information related to the problem vaccine in 2018. From the perspective of various types of media reports (see Table 1), the amount of relevant information reported by microblog was 5095066, accounting for 89.89% of the total amount; the amount of relevant information reported by wechat was 174739, accounting for 3.08% of the total. The coverage of microblog and wechat accounts for more than 90% of the total amount. The information broadcast of emerging social media occupies a major position in media reporting,

and the amount of information broadcast far exceeds the traditional media such as websites, forums, news and so on. The emerging social media has become the main platform for the discussion of related topics, and microblog has become the main media leading the online public opinion. On the 21st, in just two hours, the king of vaccines and related topics reached 1.451 million pieces of related information, and 1.347 million pieces of micro blog information, accounting for 92.87%. It has become the main platform for event network communication and public opinion hot discussion, followed by wechat platform.

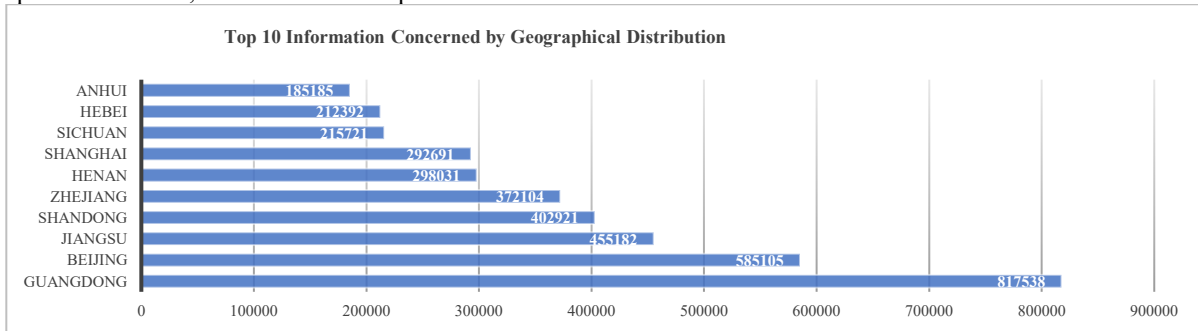


Figure 2 Geographical distribution of attention to the vaccine events of longevity problem

According to the geographical distribution of the event followers (see Figure 2), Guangdong netizens are the most concerned, with 817538 pieces of information highlighted. In addition, Internet users in Beijing, Jiangsu, Shandong and other places are also more concerned about this matter. With the unfolding of the incident, it also spread to Henan, Anhui and other provinces that have

been found to be involved in the problem vaccine. The regional public opinion also continued to rise, showing a low light. The longevity vaccine event has broken through the regional restrictions and circles, and its influence has radiated to the whole country, and has become a hot topic among the whole people.

### 3.3 Analysis of online public opinion on the longevity vaccine event

#### 3.3.1 Analysis of netizens' topics

The problem vaccine event caused a lot of attention of netizens, and the topic of online public opinion was gushing. After analysis, the words "problem vaccine", "longevity", "ineffective supervision", "thorough investigation", "sentence", "fraud", "health", "anger" and "trust" have become the core words in the network communication process of related events. Throughout the event, netizens' topics are mainly divided into three aspects: vaccine production, vaccine safety and vaccine supervision. Specifically, first, thoroughly investigate the problem vaccine and severely punish the enterprises involved. Online big V @ Liu qiangdong, @ Zhang Jie, @ Liu Xuan and others published articles on social media, asking the relevant departments to strictly investigate the enterprises involved and severely punish the person in charge of the enterprises. The comments of the network big V have been followed up and forwarded by many grassroots netizens. Second, they worry about health risks and distrust the vaccine industry. Some netizens checked the vaccination record book and found that their children had been vaccinated with the problem vaccine, and they were worried that there would be side effects and potential health risks. Although authoritative medical experts have made explanations, there are still netizens expressing concerns about continuing to vaccinate on time, supplementary vaccination, and the quality of domestic vaccines. The third is to question the regulatory issues and look forward to the authority truth. Netizens believe that there are loopholes in vaccine regulation, and many problematic vaccines are flowing into the market and injected into children's bodies, exposing problems in the supervision of vaccine circulation. Questioning the response of the enterprises involved, some netizens

believed that the response of Changsheng bio was not worthy of the public's trust because of its lack of basic sincerity. Some netizens also pointed out that Changsheng biological response did not give a reasonable solution, did not accept apology, should let Changsheng biological bankruptcy delisting.

#### 3.3.2 Emotional analysis of netizens

There were 5668087 pieces of information and 3663254 pieces of sensitive information, accounting for 64.63% of the total number of network dissemination information of the vaccine event of longevity problem, which shows the strong negative sentiment of public opinion. According to the statistical chart of netizens' emotions (see Figure 4), among the negative emotions, 33.37% netizens expressed anger, 9.93% expressed sadness, 5.22% expressed fear, and 33.03% expressed neutral emotions. Through the keyword analysis of network communication, "anger" and "panic" become the main public opinion emotions, and the negative emotions account for 48.52% of the total, which indicates that the vaccine incident has caused serious negative impact on the public to a certain extent. In addition to "anger" and "panic" and other strong negative emotions, there are also "moral bottom line" and other feelings of disappointment and sadness, which laterally expresses the concern of children injected with vaccine and the anxiety of parents. At the same time when the vaccine incident triggered a large-scale negative public opinion, all kinds of news from the Internet spread in the public opinion field, and formed several topics. Under the distrust and anger caused by the problem vaccine, netizens launched hot discussions, and rumors filled the public opinion field, resulting in even more negative emotions. Later, the proposal of important instructions in the vaccine case raised the positive emotions of netizens.

#### 3.4 Response analysis of government public opinion on

longevity vaccine incident

As the contents of vaccine related public health emergencies involve professional knowledge, the investigation and disposal must be carried out by professionals and relevant departments. The government and relevant departments play a major role in public opinion response. On July 15, after the birth problem vaccine incident, the official micro blog of the State Drug Administration reported the situation to the public at the first time. The disposal of timely information disclosure by the government did not cause the popularity of online public opinion, which controlled the development of public opinion to a certain extent, and the public began to pay attention to the event. On July 18, the Centers for Disease Control and prevention in many places announced that the vaccine against longevity problems

would be discontinued. The public has been paying continuous attention to the progress of the event. On July 20, Jilin Provincial Food and Drug Administration released information on punishment cases on its official website. The public thought that the punishment was too light, causing dissatisfaction and heated discussion. Subsequently, the government and relevant departments actively involved in the investigation and handling of the incident, and timely informed the public of the handling results, to alleviate the public's anxiety to a certain extent. Under the instructions and responses of the relevant departments on July 22 and July 23, the follow-up work and progress of various media have guided the public to grasp the latest progress of the event, increased public confidence, played a good role in alleviating public opinion, and gradually decreased negative emotions.

4. DISCUSSION AND SUGGESTIONS

4.1 From the perspective of the evolution process of network public opinion, the change trend of the volume of longevity problem vaccine event is basically consistent with the evolution law of network public opinion of public health emergency.

In the precursory period, the society began to pay attention to the event, and the amount of public opinion spread gradually increased with time. Focus on the event itself, that is, the quantity, flow direction, batches involved of the vaccine, and whether to investigate and deal with the enterprises involved. In the outbreak period, with the blowout of information, the volume of voice rises sharply, and it takes only three days to make public opinion reach the peak. The focus is to pay attention to the related actions of regulatory authorities, the related public opinions of enterprises involved, and the harm of problem vaccines. In the period of fluctuation, the volume of sound is controlled, showing a decreasing trend. The public is still concerned about whether the problems in the early stage are responded to and solved. In the dissipating period, the enthusiasm of concern decreased, the volume of voice gradually decreased, and the public mainly focused on the results of the incident. The whole

evolution cycle of public opinion is about half a month. The network public opinion of public health emergencies has the characteristics of rapid occurrence and relatively slow decline in popularity.

From the above evolution trend, it can be found that the trend change of public opinion volume is consistent with the key nodes of event handling progress, and government departments play an important role in event handling. The four stages of the event are consistent with the general law of public health emergencies [3], which shows that the government can understand the evolution law of public opinion on the Internet of public health emergencies, use the trend change to guide public opinion quickly and reasonably, promote the resolution of social contradictions, and select the appropriate scheme for public opinion response and guidance.

4.2 From the analysis of network public opinion communication, the media is the booster of the development of online public opinion, and social media has become the main platform for public opinion communication of public health emergencies.

The media will have an important impact on the trend of network public opinion through the framework of social risk issues, especially in the era of network popularization

of all media, this influence is more far-reaching. [4] Social media has become a new trend of information dissemination because of its instantaneity, rapid dissemination, sharing and openness. Micro blog plays a huge role in the process of information dissemination. It is also the process of promoting the development of network public opinion, and has become the most important public opinion field. Social media also plays a role of in-depth investigation in the event of longevity vaccine, but its content needs to be confirmed and deliberated by authorities. For example, the article "king of vaccines", which has triggered the Internet topic, may present some one-sided views. Currently, the traditional media play a very important role. At the same time, due to the strong influence of network opinion leaders on the vast number of Internet users, their views and opinions play an important role in the evolution of emergency network public opinion [5]. For example, medical big V @ vaccine and science, medical blue V @ Ding Xiangyuan respectively write articles from the perspective of professional medicine to interpret the situation of vaccines rationally and objectively, Scientific answers to questions and doubts and positive guidance of public opinion have played a certain role in easing netizens' emotions. Therefore, it is very important to combine the authority of traditional media with the interactivity of social media, understand the information needs of Internet users, play the role of opinion leader, and respond to false information with the help of microblog, wechat and other platforms.

4.3 From the analysis of network public opinion topic, the public is the main force in the development of network public opinion, and negative emotion is easy to produce trust crisis.

With the help of network media, the public participate more in social public events, and play an obvious role in promoting the development and change of events. [6] In the evolution process of the network public opinion of the problem vaccine event, in the early stage, the public focus was concentrated, and the public opinion was obvious and single. The public concern focused on the unscrupulous manufacturers, children vaccination safety, and the fear and anger of the absence of supervision; with the in-depth development of public opinion, several topics were formed. Despite the diversity of public opinion topics, issues such as vaccine safety, accountability of enterprises involved, industry questioning, and ineffective supervision are still the main issues focused by all sectors of society [7]. From the above netizen topics and netizen sentiment analysis, anger and panic accelerated the spread of trust crisis in all directions. The public's trust in domestic vaccines has dropped to the freezing point, and the public's distrust has spilled from one company and one vaccine to all domestic vaccines. The public does not trust not only the enterprises involved, but also the whole vaccine industry and even the government and regulatory authorities. Risk management experts point out that once the trust collapses, it is difficult to repair it. To reestablish trust, more efforts are needed than before. Therefore,

enterprises and governments must be good at maintaining this kind of public trust.

4.4 From the government public opinion response analysis, the government plays an important role in network public opinion control, and active response can improve its credibility.

It is not difficult to find that the specific response measures taken by the government in public emergencies will affect the evolution of network public opinion, and whether the government can carry out targeted work is crucial. In the precursory period, the government and relevant departments should quickly clarify the causes and outbreak points of the incident, pay close attention to the trend of public opinion, grasp the key nodes of event handling, and conduct unified linkage disposal. If the incident occurred, the State Food and Drug Administration quickly combined with the Centers for disease control, procuratorial Bureau, Public Security Bureau and other relevant departments to carry out investigation and disposal work. In the outbreak period, it is necessary to clarify the public opinion field of the event, what are the main appeal points and controversial points of public opinion, and the views of all circles on the event, especially the views of the public. We should respond to the core concerns accurately and effectively. For example, the vaccine safety issues focused by the public, the accountability of enterprises involved, industry query, and weak supervision are the issues that relevant departments need to focus on. Then, the first time through the mainstream media timely release information, make a positive response. In the volatility period, follow-up disposal and response are also the key directions. In this incident, the State Drug Administration official micro blog will be the first time to inform the public of the situation, follow-up work and progress related reports also effectively alleviate the negative emotions of the public. In addition, the government and relevant institutions should provide various media forms of information to meet the needs of the media and the public, make full use of social media platforms such as "two micro ends", improve government participation, strengthen interaction with the public, guide public opinion, and avoid causing adverse social emotions. In particular, the responsibility of the government and relevant departments in the whole response process and sincere attitude in the face of mistakes can better improve the response effect and enhance their credibility. Only when leaders and the public express their confidence, can they express their opinions.

## 5. CONCLUSION

To sum up, the governance of network public opinion on vaccine related public health emergencies in the era of all media is urgent and important, and all parties need to play a role, mainly including the enterprises, media, Internet users, government and relevant departments that lead to the event, to seek effective solutions. First, enhance the crisis public relations ability of the parties involved. In the event of Changsheng problem vaccine, Changsheng company is the main body leading to the event, which has unshirkable responsibility. It should shoulder the

responsibility of crisis public relations in the precursor period of network public opinion. Due to the lack of crisis public relations ability of Changsheng company, after the event, it did not take effective measures to respond to queries and publicize the situation, which brought crisis to the vaccine industry. Therefore, it is very important to improve the crisis public relations ability of the parties involved. Second, improve the supervision mechanism and system construction of the government and relevant departments. Although the government and relevant departments do not need to take full responsibility for the mistakes of the enterprises involved, they have not done a good job in the supervision and system construction, so they need to take some responsibility. The government should build a vaccine supervision database platform to monitor the whole process of vaccine production, monitoring, circulation, preservation, vaccination and feedback of vaccine manufacturers, drug regulatory units, CDCs and vaccination hospitals at all levels, so as to take responsibility and improve public trust. Third, strengthen media self-discipline and play the role of opinion leaders. In the outbreak and fluctuation period of network public opinion, the media and opinion leaders should reveal the details of the problem, through in-depth excavation of the truth of the event, comprehensive and in-depth report of the event, return the truth to the public, guide and relieve the public interest demands, reverse the development trend of the crisis, reduce the destructive power of the crisis, and shoulder the responsibility of restoring the image of the industry. Fourth, increase public awareness of vaccine related public health knowledge and enhance rational behavior. The government and relevant departments should prepare for vaccine safety related information database in advance, and immediately publicize and popularize relevant knowledge through the media in the precursory period of public opinion, to guide

the rational vaccination behavior of the public.

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# Stress Analysis and Optimization Of v-Type Thrust Bar Based on Abaqus Software

**Abstract:** Under the cooperation of Anqing Huitong Automobile Parts Co., Ltd. and Jirui United Heavy Industry Co., Ltd., this paper takes the development of new product  $\Phi$  95 Series V-type thrust bar assembly as an example. Based on ABAQUS software to carry out stress analysis, the results show that the product in the end shell, mandrel need to be optimized design or use higher strength materials first. On this basis, a series of optimization measures are put forward to strengthen the performance and structural strength of V-shaped thrust bar.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

ABAQUS is a powerful finite element software for engineering simulation, which can solve problems ranging from simple linear analysis to many complex nonlinear problems. ABAQUS includes a rich element library which can simulate any geometry. It can simulate the performance of typical engineering materials. It can not only solve many structural (stress / displacement) problems, but also simulate many problems in other engineering fields. Such as heat conduction, mass diffusion, THERMOELECTRIC coupling analysis, acoustic analysis, geotechnical analysis (fluid permeability / stress coupling analysis) and piezoelectric media analysis [1-2].

## 2. STRESS ANALYSIS OF V-TYPE THRUST BAR BASED ON ABAQUS SOFTWARE

### 2.1 Overview of V type thrust bar.

According to the installation dimensions and relevant vehicle parameters provided by automobile manufacturers, the overall structure of V-type thrust bar is mainly composed of axle mounting seat, V-type end, connecting rod and frame connecting end. In the actual operation, the axle mounting seat is matched with the tapered hole in the V-shaped end through the taper shank, and relates to the compression bolt. After being compressed, the conical hole spherical hinge is fixed by the elastic retaining ring. Due to the joint action of the taper spherical hinge and the hole elastic ring, the ball joint and the fixed seat do not have relative movement, and the variable torque is generated through rubber deformation. At present, the centripetal thrust plain bearing used in the traditional V-type thrust rod is assembled between the ball joint sleeve and the ball joint mandrel. The ball head of this structure is

composed of a pair of sliding friction pairs composed of outer ring with inner spherical surface and inner ring with outer spherical surface. Bearing working surface has large bearing capacity, easy to wear and early failure.

### 2.2 Constraints of stress analysis

According to the structural characteristics of the v-bar assembly, the constraint conditions are as follows: all degrees of freedom are constrained in the plane connecting the connecting plate and the axle. All degrees of freedom are coupled on the surface of the ball pin hole. Through ABAQUS calculation, the equivalent stress cloud of the whole bar is obtained. The stress of v-bar assembly is mainly located near the connection between rod and ball head, and the maximum stress position. On the end face of the ball joint. Therefore, the area near the ball head is a relatively weak part of the whole structure, which can be used as a reference for improving the design.

### 2.3 The general idea of stress analysis.

The structural changes of the v-bar assembly are mainly reflected in the transverse bending of the ball head and the torsion of the bar. Therefore, the installation angle of v-bar and ball joint failure should be considered in the design. In this analysis, the possibility of joint simulation of nonlinear finite element analysis software ABAQUS is discussed. The results show that the method is feasible. At the same time, through ABAQUS analysis, the stress of the V-shaped thrust bar of the air suspension guide bar system of the heavy truck is simulated under the extreme turning condition. It is concluded that the part near the connection between the ball head and the bar of the V-type thrust bar is the area with large stress value, which provides a theoretical basis for the design and improvement of the v-bar structure. Based on the modal analysis of the V-type thrust bar, the first eight natural frequencies and vibration modes are obtained, and the dynamic characteristics of the V-type thrust bar are revealed, which provides a reference for the calculation and analysis of the dynamic response of the suspension system.

### 2.4 The specific process of stress analysis.

According to the vehicle parameters provided by the customer as the design input, the longitudinal normal load of the V-shaped thrust bar is 125kN, and the maximum load is 160kN. In order to improve the safety and reliability, the safety factor  $s = 2$ , and the

longitudinal ultimate load of V-shaped thrust bar is calculated by finite element method with FRAD = 320kn.

The geometric model was established by using the software of CATIA. Assuming that the bond strength between metal and rubber is not considered, the rubber and metal are considered as a whole, and the joint surface of rubber and metal has the same node. Under the premise of not affecting the calculation accuracy, the details in the model are simplified geometrically, such as removing the small fillet, adhesive thin layer on the metal surface, etc. C3d8r element of ABAQUS and c3d4 element with higher density are used to simulate metal parts and c3d8h to simulate rubber element of ball joint. The number of grids is more than 78242. The end shell, connecting rod and mandrel are made of 45 steel (normalized hb150-210), Q345B and 40Cr (quenched and tempered hardness hrc22-28), respectively. The von Mises criterion is used to obtain the stress (equivalent stress) of the structure.

### 3. STRESS ANALYSIS RESULTS AND OPTIMIZATION MEASURES OF V-TYPE THRUST BAR BASED ON ABAQUS SOFTWARE

#### 3.1 Results analysis.

Combined with the stress nephogram, the maximum stress of the end shell is 636.5mpa, which appears at the arc transition a, the maximum stress of the connecting rod is 188.8mpa, which appears in the middle of the rod, and the maximum stress of the spherical hinge mandrel is 545.1mpa, which appears at B. It can be seen from the calculation results that the end shell and mandrel need to be optimized or materials with higher strength should be used first.

#### 3.2 Optimization measures.

According to the results of finite element analysis, the following measures are taken to optimize the structural strength

Firstly, the arc transition radius R50 is changed to R8 and R25 to R50 to improve the shell strength. Secondly,

the heat treatment mode of end shell is changed from normalizing hb150-210 to quenching and tempering hrc24-28. Thirdly, the material of spherical hinge mandrel is changed from 40Cr to 42CrMo, and the hardness of quenched and tempered hrc28-32 is heat treated to improve the strength of mandrel.

In conclusion, relying on ABAQUS software, the stress analysis of V-shaped thrust rod can be realized, and the end shell and mandrel area of V-type thrust rod can be determined. In order to improve the overall performance and quality of the V-type thrust rod, it is necessary to optimize the design or use the materials with higher strength first, and then form the strategy of optimizing the structural strength.

#### 4. CONCLUSION

In summary, relying on ABAQUS software, it is possible to achieve stress analysis of V-type thrust rods, determine the end housing and spindle area of V-type thrust rods, and need to optimize the design or first use stronger materials, and thus form a strategy to optimize the strength of the structure, improving the overall performance and quality of V-type thrust rods.

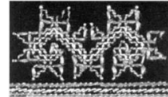

These traditional patterns contain the culture of Yao nationality and reflect the content of social life and people's aesthetic views in a certain period. Yao clothing patterns are closely related to Yao people's life and production, regional customs, religious beliefs, aesthetic concepts and so on, which are closely related to each other, so they can be widely popular in their own nation, as Table 1.

patterns are taken as the main body, and the geometric patterns form a continuous pattern, which plays the role of beautifying the main body; thirdly, the geometric

patterns are mainly used, and different geometric patterns are interspersed and combined to form a clear hierarchy. The patterns are rich in color, mainly in red, yellow, white, black five colors, bright colors, clear primary and secondary.

2.2 Brief introduction to the elements of point, line and surface

2.2.1 The basic elements of plane space are point, line and surface. The relationship among the three in philosophical meaning: point is the basis of all graphics, line is composed of numerous points, and surface is composed of several lines. In geometric meaning, the relationship among the three: point is a zero-dimensional object, a line is a one-dimensional object, and a surface is a two-dimensional object. The point, line and surface elements in product modeling are decorative patterns.

2.2.2 Relationship between point, line and surface elements and decorative pattern: point line surface is a conceptual element in plane composition and the most basic modeling unit in pattern design. It is displayed in the pattern design by means of shape, size, color, position, direction, and texture. The combination design of the three points and lines can extend the space and shape different picture language. There are many patterns in the middle point, line and surface of Yao costume pattern, and the pattern is exquisite, and the structure is mostly two or four directions continuous.

2.3 The pattern characteristics of "fish" in Yao costumes  
Yao people have long lived a nomadic farming life in mountainous areas, and fish is one of the important foods for Yao people. Influenced by the traditional Chinese culture of Han nationality, the spiritual symbol of fish and the meaning of good wishes have evolved into one of the

traditional cultural symbols of Yao nationality. Fish patterns are also constantly appearing in Yao's costumes, showing the charm and culture of fish patterns through Yao's clothing aesthetics.

2.3.1 Cultural characteristics of "fish" pattern:

2.3.1.1 The symbol of "reproduction" worship

Because the living environment of Yao people has been very bad for thousands of years, they are faced with childbirth and disease. Wild animals and other natural threats, the premature death of newborns is very high, people expect a thriving population. Because the fish spawn a lot and have a strong reproductive capacity, people borrow fish to pray for more children, hoping that the population will flourish. They worship the extraordinary reproductive ability of fish, which is the spiritual appeal to their children and grandchildren.




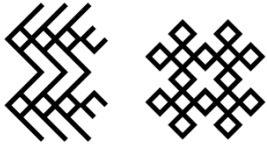




2.3.1.2 Symbol of wealth

In traditional Chinese culture, "fish" and "Yu" are homonymous. In the Tang and Song Dynasties, all the dignitaries and officials wore gold letter symbols called "fish Charms" to distinguish the noble and the poor. The Chinese folk custom pays attention to offering fish in the Spring Festival, taking the auspicious meaning of "surplus every year" (FISH).

2.3.1.3 Symbols of blessing and happiness

It has been noticed that fish (especially Koi) often swim in pairs. The image of fish is an auspicious symbol of loyalty and perfect combination. Therefore, fish are usually carved into ornaments and given to newlyweds as wedding gifts. The natural phenomenon that fish cannot live without water is the emotional expression of the love between men and women and the love between husband and wife.

2.3.1.4 Symbol of spiritual freedom

The migration history of Yao people is also a history of oppression. Yao people are eager for a free life. The state

of fish in the water resonates with people. It is also a desire for freedom and a symbol of spiritual freedom.

2.3.2 The structural characteristics of Yao's "fish" patterns

Through field investigation, the fish patterns in Yao's clothing are mainly composed of rhombus and line. The rhombus structure highlights the large body of the fish, and represents the strong reproductive capacity of the fish, reflecting the worship of the Yao people for reproduction. Because the central figure of fish pattern in Yao costume is two rhombi with different sizes. The diamond representing the shape of fish body is like the shape of eagle's eyes, which shows the meaning of animal spirits protecting human beings, and reflects Yao people's totem worship of animal spirits in mountain life. Fish patterns are closely related to Yao people through two-way continuous combination structure and four-way continuous combination pattern the existence of the land is related to the expression of Yao people's worship of land in the farming society. The combination pattern of fish pattern is mainly composed of broken line, rhombus, and triangle, as Table 2.

### 3. PRODUCTION OF WORKS

3.1 Intention, method, and design description of the work  
Based on the previous investigation and research, through the research on the "fish" pattern of Yao's clothing, taking Hezhou Yao embroidery "fish" pattern as the development object, the structure of Yao embroidery fish pattern and five colors of red, yellow, green, white, and black are extracted. Based on the theory of plane composition, the pattern design is carried out by the combination of point, line, diamond, and triangle. Through the online questionnaire survey on the theme of your favorite creative Yao "fish" pattern elements, 136 people participated in the design. The length of the long silk scarf is 87cm and the width is 5cm. The red pattern scheme is arranged from small to large to extend in a radiating manner, with gray blue edge and white color as the main color to show the fresh and fresh temperament of women. The yellow dot fish pattern elements are arranged in combination with four fish patterns to form a diamond. Through the change of the size of the single fish pattern, it is unfolded in a two-way continuous structure. The black main color is matched with the orange edge to show the low-key and elegant temperament of women. The green fish pattern is arranged continuously in two directions, repeated, and interspersed, and contrasted with positive and negative shapes to highlight the outline of the fish pattern. The design of twill and triangular patterns highlights the noble and elegant temperament of women, as Figure 1.

While promoting the dissemination of Yao ethnic culture, combined with the unique ethnic culture of Hezhou Yao nationality, the products designed can better make the cultural charm of Yao costume keep pace with the times and exchange new brand value with innovative thinking.

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# A Research on Needs and Cultivation of Business English Talents in New-Built Local Undergraduate Colleges: A Case Study of Guangxi Science & Technology Normal University

**Abstract:** Under the background of the Belt and Road initiative, the world's largest free trade area, China - ASEAN Free Trade Area has witnessed accelerated development and brought unprecedented opportunities to Guangxi regional economy. Meanwhile, it puts higher request forward to the cultivation of BE (business English) talents in China especially in Guangxi. Therefore, it is urgent for Guangxi colleges and universities to provide the appropriate BE learning environment and train qualified BE talents, and to explore practical BE talents cultivation mode is particularly important. Guided by Hutchinson and Waters' needs analysis model and theories of course design, the study adopts approaches of questionnaire and interview to investigate the social needs of BE talents of new-built local undergraduate colleges and BE major's learning needs for BE, and then analyzes the existed problems and recommends some improvement suggestions.

**Keywords:** New-built local undergraduate colleges; Business English; Needs analysis; Talents cultivation

## 1. INTRODUCTION

With the further development of economic globalization, especially after China's accession to the WTO and the Belt and Road initiative, international business activities became increasingly frequent and the demand for business talents also increased dramatically. As English has become the main language in international communication, talents who master English as well as the knowledge of international trade and business are greatly needed in China [1-8].

In China, colleges and universities have the responsibilities for cultivating professional English talents. More and more economic factors in the international communication requires that English teaching should be involved with knowledge of diplomacy, foreign affairs, trade, and finance in addition to the original literary and linguistics. Therefore, to meet the needs, English for Special Purpose (ESP, hereinafter) emerged and developed fast. Business English (BE, hereinafter), as one of the most active and the most developed branch of ESP, has drawn more and more attention in China.

As a kind of higher education in response to the regional economic development, the professional talents in local undergraduate colleges should serve the development of regional economy. All the following including implementation of The Development Program of Guangxi Beibu Gulf Economic Zone, establishment of the world's largest free trade area, China - ASEAN Free Trade Area and the Belt and Road initiative have brought unprecedented opportunities to Guangxi regional economy. Meanwhile, it put higher request forward to the cultivation of BE talents in China especially in Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region.

However, for the lack of colleges in Guangxi, poor teaching condition and low level of teaching, the current BE talents can not meet the requirements of economic development and excellent BE talents will be increasingly needed in the future. The cultivation patterns of BE talents in Guangxi undergraduate colleges now mostly focus on English language teaching, the main teaching method is just teachers' lectures and students' sit in the classroom most of the time, so the knowledge learned is out of line with society, let alone practical and operational skills of international transaction and business. This traditional cultivation patterns directly leads to that the BE talents find themselves not qualified for the real work after graduation, in other words, the BE talents can not satisfy the needs of our society and will be obsolete.

Therefore, it is urgent for those undergraduate colleges in Guangxi to provide the appropriate BE learning environment and train qualified BE talents, and to explore practical BE talents cultivation mode is particularly important.

Guided by Hutchinson and Waters' needs analysis model and theories of course design, the study adopts approaches of questionnaire and interview to investigate the social needs of BE talents of undergraduate colleges and BE major's learning needs for BE, and then analyzes the existed problems and recommends some improvement suggestions. The subjects of social needs are the employers in 15 small and medium-sized foreign trade enterprises and the contents include position demand for BE talents and requirements for English



proficiency, professional competence, comprehensive qualities and vocational qualification certificates. The subjects of learning needs are 90 BE seniors with experience of internship and the contents contain learning motivation, learning preference, viewpoints on course design, expectations of teachers and teaching method, assessments on teaching materials and evaluation system, etc.

According to the need's analysis of BE majors and relative employers, it is found that the current cultivation of BE talents can not totally meet the needs of students and the society. This study illustrates the main findings first and then tries to propose suggestions on BE training.

## 2. MAJOR FINDINGS

2.1 Based on the need's analysis of BE students, the major findings are summarized as follows:

The subjects have a positive attitude towards BE, 72% of them believe that being proficient in BE will help them to find a good job in the future. They are in great demand for business practice and operation which is in conformity with the social needs. Rich experience of practice and operation is what the market needs most for graduates. The subjects require for some more courses of business knowledge, and 83% of them think it is beneficial if they are offered more opportunities of internship and training in the three-year learning. Only by practice can students know more about their defects, and then they will have enough time to go back to colleges to improve their skills if the training and internship are conducted in sections. However, the prevailing situation among undergraduate colleges is that internship is arranged in the last year, there is no chance for them to make improvement when realizing their defects. The internship is an adaption and transition for students before they enter in the society, and it is not just an opportunity following procedures, but an opportunity to strengthen the students' competitiveness. Referring to the course design, 73% of the subjects are satisfied with the course variety, but up to 82% of the subjects complain about the courses difficulty since it is contrary to the students' competence. Besides, 75% of them are not satisfied with the course intensity for it is slack at the beginning and must speed up towards the end. They hope to take some introductory business courses in the first term.

The subjects have high expectation for BE teachers, 91% of them prefer teachers to be both proficient in English language skills and experienced in business practical operation. Regarding to language adopted in the classroom, 76% of the subjects hope teachers to speak English and Chinese in the class to help them to better understand business knowledge as well improve English proficiency. Besides, they commonly accept the learning-centered approach which encourages students to practice by themselves, and teachers help them only when they get into trouble in the process of learning.

The reality is that majority of BE teachers are proficient in English language, but when dealing with unfamiliar business knowledge, they need to learn themselves. Under the circumstance, teachers can hardly take advantage of their English proficiency. A qualified BE

teacher should attach equal importance to English language and business experiences.

Undergraduate education is linked closely with the market which is verifying continuously, the teaching and courses should be transformed accordingly. Therefore, it is very important for teachers to further study and train.

80% of the subjects are not satisfied with the textbooks because of the dull and abstract contents. They prefer more practical teaching materials rather than theoretical contents. Concerning to the version of textbooks, more than half (52%) of the subjects are fond of bilingual textbooks to understand the professional knowledge and business terms easily. Whereas another 30% of them prefer the original English textbooks for improving their communicating skills in real business English context. Almost all of them (96%) expect teacher not to explain the textbooks in the whole class but to add more supplementary knowledge relating to business.

Students complain that both the form and content of BE tests are like those of GE tests, which can not check the students' real proficiency of BE. Therefore, it is advisable to adopt all kinds of text forms such as open-book tests, closed-book examinations, essay writing and oral test into the BE tests. Furthermore, the business operational skills should be stressed in the contents of BE tests.

2.2 According to the viewpoints of the employers from foreign trade companies, the major findings are concluded as follows:

The total number of BE graduates currently has exceeded the market demand because of the booming enrollments of colleges and universities. However, with the continuous development of Guangxi Beibu Gulf Economic Zone and China - ASEAN Free Trade Area, the BE talents are still in great need, meantime, employers put forwards higher requirements for BE talents. Most BE graduates of high vocational colleges work in medium-sized and small enterprises due to their diploma.

BE majors are expected to be proficient in English language skill, especially English speaking, and writing. Referring to professional competence, employers pay more attention to effective communication skills as well as familiarity of business operational procedure, for lack of practice and training of the above-mentioned skills in colleges, they prefer to employ BE talents with working experience. Besides, employers also propose some specific requirements for comprehensive qualities such as spirit of cooperation and teamwork, hard working, learning capacity and career planning, etc.

As for qualification certificates, most employers just ask for CET-4 as the professional English certificate, but they encourage students to obtain some vocational qualification certificates since they think it can improve competitiveness in job hunting. They also advise to combine some courses with vocational qualification certificates.

## 3. SUGGESTIONS

Based on the major findings, the suggestions from this study are proposed as follows:

It should be made clear that the cultivation objectives of undergraduate colleges is training applied talents with

practical ability and innovation capability. Besides, the cultivation model should be interdisciplinary and pay attention to professional knowledge and skills except for English. What's more, the talents cultivation should be oriented by the market and stress the English applying in working circumstance. Furthermore, the positioning of BE graduates should be kept in mind, the course design should be guided by employment and fully consider the regional economy and industrial structure.

It is advisable to make relevant course integration following the principles of practicality and sufficiency; combine some courses with vocational qualification certificates to make BE majors more competitive in future employment;

The BE teaching must be transformed to learner-centered approach to arouse the enthusiasm of students in the class. Therefore, case teaching and group discussion should be flexibly adopted in the teaching process, the task-based language teaching approach can also be utilized in the teaching activities, what's more, teachers are strongly recommended to teach business English bilingually to avoid disjunction between English and business.

BE teachers should be not only masters of theoretical knowledge but also guiders to practice skills in actual production. Colleges can regularly send teachers to front-line enterprises for investigation and practice to know about the positional skills of international trade, update teachers' theoretical knowledge and train the practical capability. Besides, it is recommended to invite the experts in foreign business and trading industry to run seminars or offer business training for teachers in order to improve their business knowledge. In addition, the BE teachers are encouraged to learn business-related knowledge in their spare time as well as to take part in the examination of relative vocational qualification certificates.

Furthermore, it is also suggested to introduce some technical personnel and managerial staff as full-time or part-time teachers, and then the double-certificated teachers cooperate with experts of business and foreign trade clerk to compile original practical teaching materials with higher vocational BE characteristics and constantly revise them with the development of international trade and business.

It is necessary to build training bases in the college for BE learners to intuitively study in simulated conditions

such as business English listening and speaking training, international trade training and business documentation training, etc. As for off-campus internship, the cooperation between colleges and enterprises is worth considering. Cooperation means mutual benefit, on the one hand, the enterprises truly understand the specifications and qualifications of the talents they need, and they have advanced technology and equipment, the first-hand resources, rich practical experiences, and they superior training space to provide students with opportunities of internship so as to improve their practical competence, on the other hand, the colleges can offer qualified graduates and solve the problems of staff shortage in busy seasons of production and selling for the enterprises. In a word, both the colleges and enterprises take the responsibility of training qualified BE talents.

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# Improving the Effectiveness of Employment and Entrepreneurship Guidance Service in Colleges and Universities from The Perspective of Supply Side Reform

**Abstract:** Nowadays, there are some problems in the service of employment and entrepreneurship guidance in Colleges and universities, such as the imbalance of supply and demand, the poor entrepreneurial ability of students after graduation, and the imperfect personnel agency system. Colleges and universities should strengthen the reform of education and teaching, deepen entrepreneurship education, promote employment service, and improve personnel agency, to improve the effectiveness of employment guidance service.

**Keywords:** Innovation and entrepreneurship; Employment guidance; Balance

## 1. INTRODUCTION

In the reform of supply problem, colleges and universities put forward the guiding direction of "releasing new demand and creating new supply". The core requirement is to improve the quality of products through continuous innovation. Colleges and universities are the supply side of society and enterprises, while society and enterprises are the demand side. The quality of talents cultivated by the graduates of colleges and universities may affect the employment quality of students. Colleges and universities should further optimize the education system, provide students with high-quality employment and entrepreneurship guidance services, and cultivate high-level innovative talents for the society.

## 2. PROBLEMS FACED BY EMPLOYMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP GUIDANCE SERVICE IN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

### 2.1 Dislocation of supply and demand leads to difficulties in employment and recruitment

The imbalance between supply and demand in quantity, the number of jobs provided by many enterprises has begun to decrease due to the impact of slowing economic growth. It is precisely because the supply exceeds the demand that leads to the severe employment situation.

There is a quality contradiction between demand and training. The corresponding majors in Colleges and universities did not follow up and transform in time, nor did they run schools according to the social and economic development. They simply pursued to improve the comprehensive ability of the University and blindly opened majors, which led to structural contradictions. The professional skills and practical ability of colleges

and universities are not qualified, and the methods to solve the problems are also very poor. After the students enter the job, they must carry out training for a period, which leads to the increase of human resource cost of enterprises, thus affecting the employment. There are many students because of low learning ability, can not adapt to the post very well after the entry, resulting in resignation.

The gap between the ideal and reality of employment, the reduction of domestic large and medium-sized enterprises and multinational companies, and the employment of small enterprises has begun to increase. However, when students choose employment units, they still prefer public institutions and state-owned enterprises. They are not willing to choose towns, small and medium-sized enterprises. In the employment area, most people will choose the first-line large cities and coastal areas, and then choose the provincial capital city Cities, economically underdeveloped cities and western regions are not considered at all. Students prefer to be unemployed in big cities, rather than go to the grassroots for employment. They lack the spirit of hard work and grassroots success, and their employment mentality is not practical enough [1].

Supply and demand information is not symmetrical enough. Some colleges and universities do not collect and sort out the recruitment information in time, which will lead to the employer can not choose the right talents, students do not know where to apply for jobs, leading to the loss of job opportunities. There are also some students who have not participated in the enterprise recruitment of the double election meeting, which leads to the asymmetry of supply and demand information.

### 2.2 The innovation ability of graduates is poor and the success rate of entrepreneurship is not high

At present, China's innovation and entrepreneurship education is still in the stage of theoretical knowledge teaching, and has not formed a systematic and scientific concept of innovation and entrepreneurship education, which also leads to the students do not have enough space for innovative thinking and play, and there is no opportunity to practice in social activities. The growth of graduates and economic development have a great impact on innovation and entrepreneurship education, but now colleges and universities still do not take the concept of

innovation and entrepreneurship education as the cultivation of students' comprehensive quality. At present, domestic education is in the student department, employment guidance office, academic affairs office and other relevant departments, and there is little interaction between these departments. Most of the innovation and entrepreneurship courses are conducted in the form of lectures and elective courses, which are neither systematic nor combined with the professional teacher training plan, so there is no professional characteristics at all.

In addition, most of the teachers are lack of innovation ability and entrepreneurial experience, and the level of the teaching staff needs to be improved. Only a high-level teacher team can guarantee the implementation of entrepreneurship and innovation education. Innovation and entrepreneurship teachers should not only have professional knowledge, but also have interdisciplinary comprehensive knowledge and entrepreneurial practice technology ability. At present, most of the innovation and entrepreneurship teachers in Colleges and universities are cadres of students' employment guidance work, without perfect theoretical knowledge of innovation and entrepreneurship and without entrepreneurial experience. In the ordinary classroom, it is only the interpretation of employment policy and etiquette skills, which can not systematically guide entrepreneurship practice, so that students' innovation and entrepreneurship awareness and ability can not be effectively improved [2].

The practice of innovation and entrepreneurship education is very weak, and the conversion rate of classroom effect is low. Now the basic task is to apply innovation and entrepreneurship education to the market and practical activities. Let theory be applied to practice, and then practice is used to test the truth. Practical activities are the basis of innovation and entrepreneurship ability. The lack of practical activities will hinder students' innovation passion and make their creativity unable to play. Most of the innovation and entrepreneurship activities in Colleges and universities are carried out in the form of competitions. The activity system is not perfect enough to provide students with an effective entrepreneurial practice platform. Although students are highly involved, they can not get real practical training. Most of the students participate only to complete the competition, not to experience the significance of practical activities.

### 3. THE PERSONNEL AGENCY SYSTEM IS NOT PERFECT AND THE EFFICIENCY OF TALENT FLOW IS TOO LOW

Colleges and universities do not pay enough attention to the personnel agency of graduates, and the publicity is not in place. The personnel agency system has been developed in China for decades, but the importance of human resource allocation has not been fully played. The important part of personnel agency work of college graduates is not well publicized. Files are also delivered by mail. Students have never seen their own files, do not understand the importance of personal files, and are very vague about their own files. When they are employed,

they have little knowledge of the transfer process of their own archives, do not know the whereabouts of the archives, and do not care about the follow-up of the archives, which leads to the serious phenomenon of "abandoning archives"[3].

There is also the lag of personnel agency management. After graduation, the personnel files are separated after the graduate's hand over the personnel files to the talent market, so that the information in the work can not be added to the personal files, so that the files can not be updated. Personnel files still only record the performance of graduates in school. Personnel agencies only manage and keep the files in a static way. They can't understand the dynamic changes of graduates in the working process. They don't have the function of identifying talents from the files. They can't reflect the characteristics of individual talents, and the distinction between talents is not obvious. The management effect is poor, and the phenomenon of disconnection often occurs. College graduates must move frequently in various regions. However, the personnel agencies have no way to move along with the movement, and the personnel agencies between regions have no cooperation. The information is seriously blocked, which has great inconvenience to the flow and exchange of college graduates, and the employment agencies can not accurately understand the characteristics and characteristics of graduates. It is impossible to adjust the flow direction of human resources.

### 4. CONCLUSION

The reform of supply side structure is to correct the imbalance of supply and demand structure by means of reform, reduce ineffective and low-end supply, increase the supply of medium and high-end enterprises, reduce the flow of factors, optimize the allocation, and achieve a high-level balance of supply and demand. The supply side reform has consolidated the concept of social development in the new era, which is of great strategic significance to China's overall development and has a profound impact on history. Under the background of the current era, colleges and universities must implement the strategy of education reform and innovation. By improving the education system, optimizing the discipline structure, building a high-level teacher team, strengthening practical teaching, strengthening employment guidance education, improving the quality of college employment clothing, improving the personnel agency system, strengthening the reasonable flow of talents, training high-quality comprehensive talents, so as to achieve the standard of supply and demand. To balance, let college students full and reasonable employment.

**Abstract:** GIS teaching course in English has the advantages of close knowledge points, high teaching quality for undergraduates, and strengthening students' ability of English communication in professional courses. Based on the above defects, the author consciously strengthened the guidance on GIS practical operation training in the design course and extra-curricular training for high level grade students. ## 1. INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE BACKGROUND

The mode of All-English-Teaching is fit for students in Architectural and Urban and Rural Planning major to promote the implementation of our university's international education strategy and cultivate a group of high-quality compound talents. The reasons are as follows [1-2].

1.1 GIS not only brings students in different majors' improvement of drawing efficiency, but also includes the comprehensive support of information management, geographic spatial-temporal analysis, scheme evaluation, decision support, etc.

1.2 The softwares students used in this course are all Trial-Version in English. In order to strength their mastery of various knowledge points, there will be a lot of interactive operational demonstrations in class. Both are conducive for students to learn English and the software of ArcGIS well.

## 2. COURSE ANALYSIS

### 2.1 Contents and requirements

The course has 32 hours, including 24 hours for theory teaching and 8 hours for practice. It follows the teaching design method from easy to difficult, from foundation to application.

The first part is GIS Cognition with 8 hours.

For the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> hour, students are required to master the conception, composition and professional terms of GIS and ArcGIS, and to preliminarily understand the relationship among ArcGIS, ArcMap, ArcCatalog, ArcScene, and ArcGlobe. The installation process of each module unit of ArcGIS software is demonstrated. And students are required to complete the installation after class.

In 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> hour, taking the case as the starting point, new technology of digital city and GIS development are

introduced for students. The aim is to promote students better understanding the functions of ArcGIS in practical application.

From 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> hour, basic concepts and demonstrations are taught for students. Theoretical explanations are as follows. a) to explain the relationship among map file, data file, and layer. b) to explain the difference between relative path storage and absolute path storage. c) to teach the concept and application of data frame, etc. Basic demonstrations are for ArcMap, ArcCatalog, ArcScene, and ArcGlobe. For example, we need to learn how to create, open or store a new map file, and how to use ArcCatalog to manage discrete files.

The second part is Data Management with 8 hours.

From 9<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> hour, students need to know four categories of data type. They are vector data, raster data, table data, and text data. The characteristics and related operations are explained for all students.

The third part is Mapping with 2 hours.

In 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> hour, students are required to distinguish between Geographic Coordinate System and Projected Coordinate System. They are required to define coordinates and change coordinates independently.

The fourth part is Visualization with 4 hours.

In 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> hour, students are required to label point data, polyline data, and polygon data and finish labeling road name and land use properties, converting road name labels into geodatabase annotation, and add place names to map document annotation.

In 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> hour, a series of planning geographic data modeling methods of ArcGIS are introduced to demonstrate how to create map files for students, such as database building, mapping, editing, etc.

The fifth part is Geoprocessing Demonstration with 10 hours. It's the link of spatial analysis by using GIS analysis tools. [1-2] The basic content depends on the teaching requirements.

### 2.2 Teaching advantages

2.2.1 To meet the requirements of "Professional Norms Guiding for Urban and Rural Standardization in Colleges and Universities" in 2013 edition, the teaching rhythm is with high quality intensively.

2.2.2 The teacher and students communicate with each other in all English, which strengthen students' ability to master the language of English.

### 2.3 Teaching disadvantages

2.3.1 Students only have time to learn the knowledge of data type, spatial coordinates, visualization, and some geoprocessing practice. They lack the ability on how to collect and input data. So, they only can do some work

after they get the ready-made data.

2.3.2 Some students still have understanding difficulties. One reason is that they have poor English background. The other reason is that they are lazy to preview professional norms before class.

3. PRACTICE

In order to effectively solve the problems in teaching part, it's necessary to increase the application of GIS in other practical parts.

Since the course is offered in the second semester of junior year, the students are senior students of grade four or grade five.

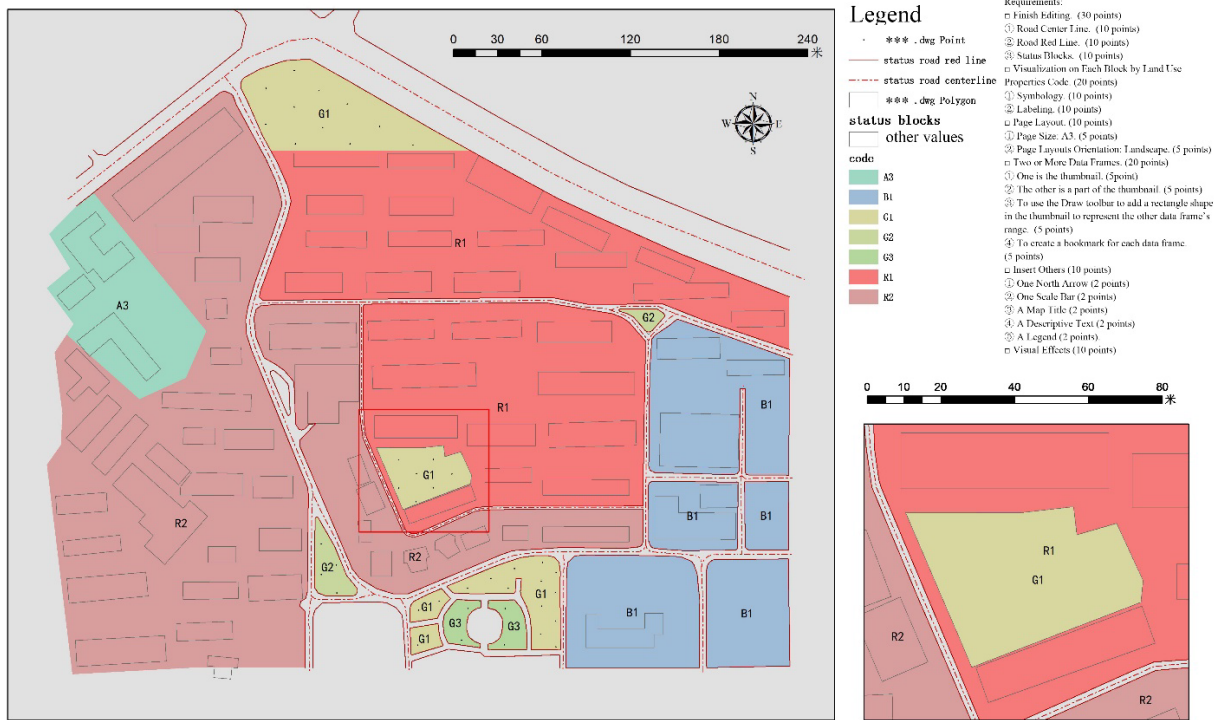


Fig. 1 Sample Picture of Students' Practice (Source: by author)

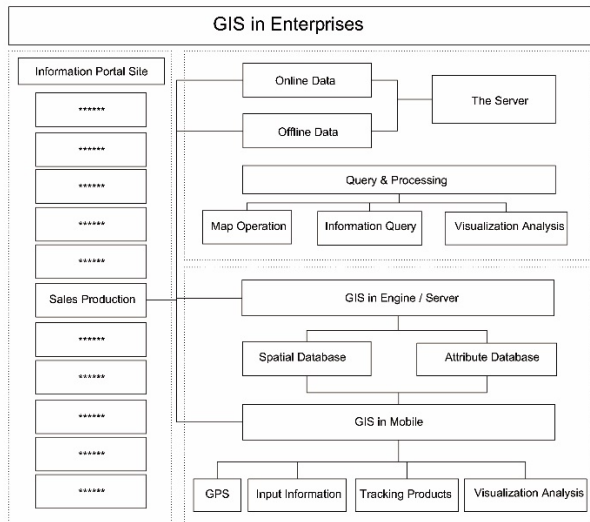


Fig. 2 One Enterprise's IMP Scheme (Source: by group members)

3.1 Two Cases in Class

Designing course is the most important main course for architectural and urban and rural students. It's the main carrier of professional ability training. According to students' interests, the operation and application of GIS will be appropriately increased.

3.1.1 Case I: Production Practice of fifth-year students-

industrial tourism planning of an enterprise.

The production practice is an integral part of the horizontal project "Construction Scheme of One Enterprise's IMP (Information Management Platform)", with 5 student members. The work related to GIS is as follows.

3.1.1.1 Through multi-channel collection of tourism planning data information where the enterprise located, sorting out and inputting into GIS for analysis.

3.1.1.2 To establish the enterprise's IMP with ArcGIS software.

3.1.1.3 To finish the noise test, thermal and humidity test, and light test. And according to the test data, team members need to complete the visualization processing with the GIS software.

3.1.1.4 To complete the construction of a commodity sales IMP. It includes: sorting out original data, data processing with GIS, etc.

3.1.2 Case II: Graduation Project in fifth-year students- Research on the Protection, Restoration, and Development Planning of One Famous Site.

This graduation project includes 4 student members. The work related to GIS is as follows.

3.1.2.1 To build up the heritage IMP with ArcGIS and Revit software.

3.1.2.2 To analyze spatial information with ArcGIS software, just like elevation processing.

Through above study, the five-student-member team and the four-student-member team have expressed that they have a general understanding of the construction of IMP.

**3.2 One Case after Class: Summer Work Camp Practice**  
The time of summer work camp is in the middle of July every year. It's usually in the first or second week of summer vacation. It's about 10 days. Students in this group should have the foundation of ArcGIS software operation. And the number of students is unlimited.

Taking a summer work camp as an example, the research topic is "Research on Optimal Design of one Ancient City Tourism Route". Thirteen students applied for the subject, and one graduate student and six junior undergraduates were employed at last.

The summer camp was divided into three stages.

The first stage is the preparatory work before the investigation of the ancient city. The teacher and students in the group held some meetings for discussion to solve difficulties on principle, method, and research focus in this topic. Students should finish research planning arrangement.

The second stage is investigation. Students should finish the work of information collection.

The third stage is geoprocessing. Students need to complete the supplementary work of data collection. They should sort out and input all collected data, and complete the geoprocessing work of route with ArcGIS software.

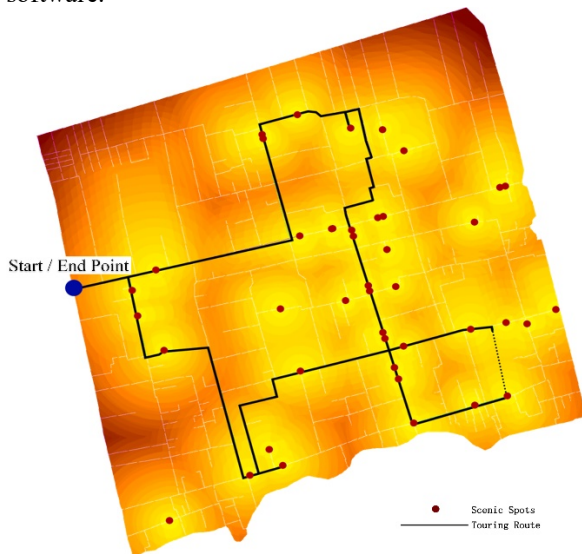


Fig. 3 Route Design of One-Day-Tour in Ancient City (Source: by group members)

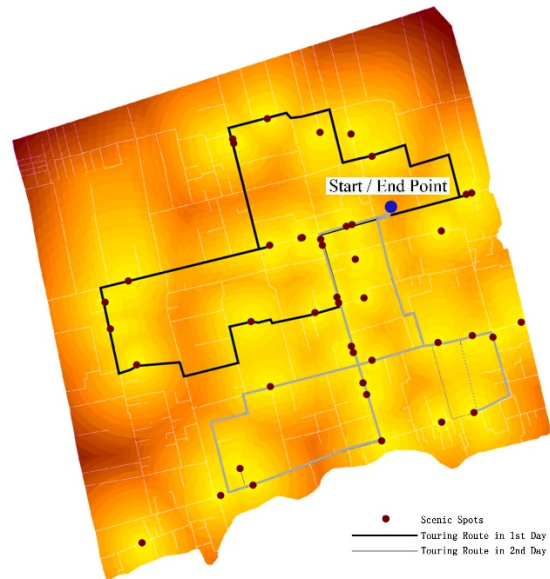


Fig. 4 Route Design of Two-Day-Tour in Ancient City (Source: by group members)

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# Control Strategy Based on Power Electronic Transformer in Hybrid Microgrid

**Abstract:** Power electronic transformer is used in hybrid microgrid because of its light weight and small loss. Because of this characteristic of power electronic transformer, effective control can make power electronic transformer play a real role in changing voltage. On this basis, this paper briefly analyzes the characteristics and principles of power electronic transformer. The application quality of power electronic transformer can be improved by optimizing power grid mode, controlling phase-shifting start-up, realizing indirect closed-loop, and implementing adaptive switching.

**Keywords:** Power electronic transformer; Hybrid microgrid; Grid mode

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The emergence of hybrid microgrid can create favorable conditions for the application of new energy such as wind energy. The reasonable control of power electronic transformer can promote the hybrid microgrid to have a good voltage protection function, and avoid the low power supply efficiency caused by the instability of energy supply. Therefore, scientific control planning should be made according to the actual characteristics of power electronic transformer, to promote the long-term development of power grid [1-3].

## 2. CHARACTERISTICS AND PRINCIPLES OF POWER ELECTRONIC TRANSFORMER

Compared with the traditional power transformer, power electronic transformer has smaller volume and lower no-load loss, which is not easy to form harmonic phenomenon, but also has higher conversion frequency. Therefore, its application in hybrid microgrid can effectively enhance the power supply performance. The hybrid microgrid was first proposed in 2001. In the development stage of new energy power supply modes such as wind energy and solar energy, hybrid microgrid, as a kind of distributed generation, can accept the grid. It has high stability and emergency power supply function, to meet the demand of power supply in the new era. In fact, the research and development of power electronic transformer is mainly to solve the problems of large load and large volume existing in the past transformer. The larger the transformer is, the lower the operation frequency will be, which will affect the power supply performance. Therefore, the power electronic transformer can play an appropriate role in raising the voltage and frequency.

During the actual operation of power electronic transformer, it needs to use the converter and transformer to realize the smooth output of AC voltage in the phase of frequency conversion. In addition, with the help of high

frequency transformer, the power electronic transformer can make the power converter reach the expected voltage value, and finally promote the stable operation of the power grid. In AC conversion, the application of power electronic transformer can effectively carry out the reasonable conversion of power energy. Therefore, power electronic transformer has important application value in hybrid microgrid. It is necessary to take effective measures to control it, ensure the power supply quality of hybrid microgrid, and gradually promote it, to create greater economic benefits for various power consumption enterprises [1].

## 3. CONTROL STRATEGY BASED ON POWER ELECTRONIC TRANSFORMER IN HYBRID MICROGRID

### 3.1 Optimization of power grid mode

When the power electronic transformer is connected in hybrid microgrid, the current signal can be transferred to the power grid according to the current converter. At this time, it is not easy to be affected by the geographical location and block the current connection. In fact, the power electronic transformer can regulate the voltage of hybrid microgrid in the actual use stage, and then eliminate the adverse effects of harmonics. There are mainly two connection modes in hybrid microgrid, and feasible control suggestions can be put forward according to different modes, to make transformers in hybrid microgrid have stronger adaptability.

First, the grid connected mode, in the hybrid microgrid, the power electronic transformer can be used as a carrier to realize the effective connection with the main grid. In the grid connected mode, power electronic transformer can regulate the power. On the one hand, when the load loss occurs, it can absorb the given energy in time, and when the load loss occurs in the hybrid microgrid, it can produce impedance effect, provide the required energy in the hybrid microgrid, and then in this supply process, ensure the stability of the hybrid microgrid and avoid grid operation failure caused by power loss. On the other hand, the application of power electronic transformer can also output distributed current through the low-voltage side of DC to make the power supply of power grid in a controllable state. Therefore, it is necessary to pay attention to the effect of load power supply in grid connected mode [2-3].

Second, off grid mode, the so-called off grid mode refers to the hybrid microgrid in the main grid disconnected state, in this stage, the power flow in the hybrid microgrid is frequent. In order to avoid the power load phenomenon, the power electronic transformer should maintain the distribution and modulation functions. In order to ensure

that the hybrid microgrid can also maintain stable operation in the off-grid mode, the control mode of increasing the regulation speed can ensure that the power flow direction is limited, and the power grid stability is reduced due to the influence of power "scattered everywhere". In general, power real-time monitoring can be carried out in hybrid microgrid, which can not only master the power flow direction and reactive power generation, but also provide reliable basis for the stable operation of hybrid microgrid, and finally promote the rational distribution of power again. Therefore, the power electronic transformer in the hybrid microgrid off grid mode, the use of good power monitoring work, to ensure the quality of power grid operation.

### 3.2 Start phase shift handle

When applying power electronic transformer in hybrid microgrid, in order to ensure high quality and strong stability of power grid operation, it is necessary to take effective control measures from phase-shifting start-up to eliminate the adverse impact of impulse current on power grid. There are three reasons for the phase-shift start-up phenomenon: first, the high-frequency converter often needs to generate excitation current to achieve the purpose of charging in the voltage conversion stage, and then the impulse current will be formed, which will bring resistance to the power electronic transformer connected in the hybrid microgrid. The second is that the low-voltage side of the associated port exceeds the rated standard, which causes the power electronic transformer to produce strong fluctuations, and finally changes its operation state; the third is that the voltage values formed at the parallel side are obviously different, which makes the actual application effect affected by the impact circulating current after starting. If the phase-shifting start-up phenomenon is not solved in time, the practicability of power electronic transformer in hybrid microgrid will be reduced, and even can not play a role in power regulation. Accordingly, suggestions for improvement can be put forward from the following three parts:

Firstly, the internal phase-shifting starting device is set in the power electronic transformer to reduce the impulse current.

Second, the indirect and direct dual control means can realize the current cross control on the internal phase-shifting starting device, to achieve the purpose of optimal control.

Third, a new false load resistance is added to prevent the generation of impact circulating current through the resistance's blocking effect on the current.

The internal phase-shifting control is to isolate the pulse current by setting the control switch at the low-voltage side, while the indirect phase-shifting control is to change the phase-shifting angle by delaying the operation. Therefore, in the control phase of power electronic transformer in hybrid microgrid, attention should be paid to the phase-shifting start-up. In addition, the intermediate relay can also be used to realize the efficient operation of the converter, to avoid the influence of impulse current and impulse circulating current, and the

success rate can not be reasonably distributed.

### 3.3 Realize indirect closed loop

In the control stage of power electronic transformer, the indirect closed-loop method can also be used to improve its performance, which can promote the stability of hybrid microgrid in the future power supply process. In fact, the indirect closed-loop is to promote the IP regulator to have good output function with the help of the voltage converter controller. After that, it can adjust the voltage value of the high-voltage side. The maximum regulated voltage is not more than 22kv, and then the low-voltage side voltage can be maintained at about 560V. Finally, the low-voltage control and non-adjustable problems caused by open-loop operation can be avoided. During the operation of power electronic transformer, reasonable modulation can be carried out according to the voltage value generated in the hybrid microgrid, and then the bidirectional flow results can be achieved in the voltage output stage, to avoid the damage of voltage sudden change on the stability of power grid operation.

In order to ensure that the power electronic transformer in hybrid microgrid is in a good control environment, a new control strategy can also be proposed by "simulation test". First, the AC test voltage can be set at 10kV, the switching frequency is 10kHz, the DC voltage at the high voltage side is between  $\pm 9KV$  and  $\pm 11kv$ , and the series parallel connection voltage is 1000V and 560V respectively. After that, the simulation curve is observed. Through the relevant analysis results of the simulation test, it can be found that: in the 50  $\mu s$  simulation period, after 1 s, the power electronic transformer appears full load phenomenon, and the DC voltage suddenly drops to 560V. At this time, under the indirect closed-loop operation, the DC voltage at the high-voltage side can be detected. Among them, the current balance is good, and the current in the hybrid microgrid does not rise or fall suddenly due to the change of voltage, which ultimately increases the stability of power grid operation. Therefore, in order to create a good voltage regulation environment for power electronics, effective measures should be taken to regulate the unbalanced current formed in the open-loop state to promote the stable operation of hybrid microgrid system. Only by ensuring the good performance of transformer devices in hybrid microgrid, can the security and stability of power grid system be maximized.

### 3.4 Implement adaptive switching

In the traditional sense, if the hybrid microgrid needs to achieve fault maintenance behavior during its operation, the traditional regulation method is to rely on the communication network to master the fault information. Now, with the help of power electronic transformer, the self-adaptive switching maintenance mode can be realized, to avoid the problems such as delayed repair in the troubleshooting stage, which will affect the operation efficiency of hybrid microgrid. Generally, it is necessary to control according to the following contents: when the power electronic transformer fails, the grid connection conditions can be checked in the locked state. If the grid connection conditions are not consistent with the grid

connection conditions, the connection channel of hybrid microgrid will be immediately transferred to avoid the influence of transformer performance and the output of success rate will be affected. At the same time, the hybrid microgrid can also carry out automatic troubleshooting to check whether there are grid faults, and ultimately promote the hybrid microgrid to complete the maintenance task as soon as possible, to avoid prolonging the reconnection time of the grid. In addition, in the adaptive switching of hybrid microgrid, the connection port can be converted, and the performance of power electronic transformer can be detected. Once the voltage value is found to be reduced, it can be inferred that the transformer has grid connection fault, and the DC voltage will be the main control module. In order to improve the power regulation quality of power electronics, the self-adaptive switching mode can also be used to improve the troubleshooting speed, so that the hybrid microgrid can maintain a good operation state with the assistance of the new transformer, and prevent the influence of power supply effect in the power grid fault stage.

The hybrid microgrid has AC and DC power, and can be indirectly connected with the main grid. Therefore, in the adaptive conversion, the operation state of each power equipment in the system can be effectively controlled by the test platform, to improve the quality of power supply. In the hybrid microgrid, the self-adaptive switching device can also be used to achieve customized upgrading, which can make the hybrid microgrid maintain good stability in the power supply process, to avoid the

influence of traditional transformer load consumption and reduce the power supply efficiency, so as to realize the optimal power supply control.

#### 4.CONCLUSION

To sum up, the application of power electronic transformer in hybrid microgrid, in order to promote the hybrid microgrid show significant advantages and obtain stable power supply and consumption state, we should start from the aspects of grid mode, phase shift starting, indirect closed-loop, adaptive switching, etc. To ensure that the power electronic transformer highlights the real value during the actual operation of the hybrid microgrid, to meet the specific needs of the power supply industry in the new era.

For example, for the translation of the word "Kung Fu", in the English context, when you see the word, you will first translate it into "effort", "art" or "labor", while during the teaching period, teachers can translate "Kung Fu" into "Kung Fu". The translation of "Fu" is extended and the English translation of Kung Fu is reflected in the teaching. Fu is not as commonly used in daily life as the previous three arbitrary, but "Kung Fu" is the representative product of Chinese traditional culture, which can better reflect the Chinese people's awareness of practicing martial arts and exercising since ancient times.
