" Smartphones and all-encompassing network coverage have led to the rapid rise of selfmedia. Self-media has not only enriched people's lives, but also formed a unique selfmedia economic industry. Short self-media videos of the "Three Rural Issues" have also emerged, with agriculture, the countryside and farmers as the main focus and content. the importance of the "three rural" selfmedia in rural economic development, rural cultural dissemination and the building of rural spiritual civilisation is becoming more and more prominent.

In August 2020, in order to support the content creation of the platform's three farmers' selfpublishing media, Jitterbit launched the "New Farmer Programme" and the "Entry Gift Pack" to encourage farmers' bloggers to enter the platform, and the "Farmer Scoreboard" to encourage farmers' bloggers to create, and the "New Farmer Recommendation Officer" to help more good products to be seen, giving "three farmers" creators support in various forms. the "Farmer Scoreboard" encourages the creation of farmer bloggers, and the "New Farmer Recommendation Officer" helps more good products to be seen. Various forms of support are given to the creators of the "Three Rural Areas", so that more people can see the beautiful countryside, and more people can discover the beautiful agricultural products. In June 2022, Dong Yuhui was selected by the East after the fire, but also attracted more Shake Voice users, making Shake Voice become one of the top traffic platforms. the three agricultural bloggers on this platform are representative.

2. ZIBO CITY, "THREE RURAL" SELF-MEDIA SHORT VIDEO DEVELOPMENT STATUS QUO

Zibo City, currently living in the countryside, to shoot rural life, rural food, spread rural culture and continue to update, the amount of silk in the "100, 000 +" more than the representative of the "three rural" short video blogger mainly "Jiu Yue's" "happy life" "mountain sister" "Farmer Yingzi" "food Xiaoxi Happiness of life", "mountain sister", "Farmer Yingzi", "food Xiaoxi" and so on. Although the number of works of these bloggers are very different, but the shooting style, content is basically similar: First, the rural life category, combined with their own life in the countryside, to share the planting of vegetables, orchard management and picking, reservoirs and fish ponds, fishing, catching the market, and other unique life in the countryside; the second is the family food category, the main filming of home-cooked food, rural specialties, and the process of making Netflix food; the third is the family's daily life story category, mainly to show that family and neighbourhood anecdotes are the main, in order to attract fans, but also to add a lot of humourous and funny elements, "Food Xiaoxi" blogger is more obvious in this regard, and his

fan base is also the largest. From the videos posted by bloggers, you can see that food is the easiest way to attract fans and get the number of likes. However, the video that can really cause a fire is not necessarily food, but a video that can resonate with netizens' emotions. the key conditions of good video content provide users with emotional value. The popular "three agricultural" short videos can also spread because they can empathise with netizens and provide emotional value to users.

3. ZIBO CITY, "THREE RURAL" MEDIA DEVELOPMENT HAS ITS OWN SHORTCOMINGS AND SHORTCOMINGS

3.1 Compared with other well-known "three rural" short video IPs on the Shake Voice platform, the characteristics are not distinctive enough, and the video viewing degree is not enough. There are more imitations and less innovations.

3.2 Attracting followers while adding drama and losing their own character development and moulding in the rush to cash in. There is a move towards entertainment by some bloggers, but spoofing does not currently exist.

3.3 "Zibo barbecue" huge flow did not give "three agricultural" short video bloggers to bring big impact. Zibo barbecue in March 2023 after the fire, the above four bloggers have sent homemade "Zibo barbecue" video, but the number of views and likes are not high. Several bloggers basically also produced videos of Zibo's speciality foods such as Boshan jerky, fried pot cake, purple rice cake, etc., but the spread and influence was not great.

3.4 Lack of display and dissemination of outstanding rural culture. "Three rural" short video, not only is the rural landscape, daily life recorders, it is also the order of rural rituals and customs, folklore, is the display of the rural spirit. Blogger "Jiu Yue's happy life" her work connotation is richer, she put the rural landscape, food, clothing, objects and other material content, and rural traditional customs, civilised culture, kinship and other spiritual content, the video content of the shooting shows the countryside simple family has contradictions and full of love life. Good qualities such as hardworking and capable, simplicity and kindness are all reflected. the number of spreads and likes of her video is relatively high. Other bloggers have done a poorer job of showing the good countryside culture.

4. EXPLORING THE PATH OF RURAL ECONOMIC REVITALISATION AND CULTURAL DIFFUSION

4.1 Focus on innovation and local characteristics to create a distinctive personal brand

In recent years, Zibo City to create a national historical and cultural city. Chinese outstanding traditional culture "two" benchmark city, internationally renowned tourist destination city as a guide, to create a new high ground of culture and tourism. Relying on the advantages of self-media, culture can not only be widely disseminated and gain a lot of attention, but also help to revitalise the forgotten rural culture and obtain long-term development through diversified language exchanges and collisions.

4.3 The government should increase policy support and guidance

First, adhere to dialogue and consultation to build a world of lasting peace. "Lasting peace is a prerequisite for the development and prosperity of all countries, and dialogue and consultation is the solution to peace for all countries in the world. "[11] Second, we need to pursue cooperation and shared benefits to build a prosperous and secure world. Only through joint contribution, sharing and winwin cooperation can we build a "governance pattern of universal security and an economic system of common prosperity" [12]. Third, we need to build an open and inclusive world through exchanges and mutual learning. Exchanges and mutual learning, "promote dialogue between different civilizations and different development exchange modes, learn from each other through competition and comparison, and develop together through exchanges and mutual learning" [13]. Fourth, adhere to green and low-carbon, and build a

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clean and beautiful world. "The concept of a community with a shared future for mankind emphasizes that economic development and ecological protection are not separate and opposed, but can go hand in hand, and 'clear waters and green mountains are gold and silver mountains'" [14]. To achieve the sustainable development of the world with a green and low-carbon lifestyle.

4. THE ORIGIN AND CHANGE OF THE HORSE LANTERN WASHING PARTY 4.1 Origin

There are two origins of the horse washing festival.

One is from the marriage between the two clans of He Ye. During the Kangxi years of the Qing Dynasty, Ye had created a Xima River bridge, which was damaged by floods in the Qianlong Yiyou year, and then the two families became married and jointly funded the reconstruction of the Xima Bridge. According to the Ye people, the Ye and He families lived across the river and married during the Qianlong period. On the day of marriage, the daughter of the Ye family was unwilling to go to the car. Father asked the reason, the daughter cried for Ye Fu to build a bridge to facilitate the return home. Ye Fu afraid of delay, hurriedly agreed. Later, before the two families repaired the bridge, "Worshiping incense and praying on an auspicious day moved the holy. "According to legend, at noon of that day, an old man rode a white horse back and forth under the bridge, twice to the west through the east bank, east through the west bank, the horse walked on the water and jumped, the horse stood under the bank of the west bank, the old man sat on the pagoda stone table, the worker came forward and asked: 'Ask the old man, see if this bridge can be repaired? the old master said, "We must repair the foundation of the bridge and follow the footsteps of the horse. " After that, the horse jumped ashore, and the old man rode a white horse into the street without a trace. Urgent ask street neighbors, etc., all said do not know also. A rumor of all the family name, all know, there is said that the Lord of the Xishan Temple King show holy, should be holy God, blessing according to my land also. East and west sides, He Ye two ethnic groups, successive marriages and friends, Qinjin

friendship. To this end, the two families agreed to rebuild the bridge. He Xiuxi seven blocks, Ye Xiudong thirteen blocks, the length of the bridge is a total of 20 blocks, engraved with the inscription, the bridge was completed in Qianlong Wu Zi year Meng Chunyue "[15]. Later, due to the completion of the Spring Festival, people held a Lantern Festival in the Lantern Festival to commemorate the achievements of the He Ye two families. This is the earliest origin of the horse lantern washing. the second is from Pei's brother Jiangxi adventure. According to the old generation of Hu Jia Ao, Xiao Jia ao oral, according to legend, in the middle and late Qing Dynasty, Hu Jia Ao has two brothers surnamed Bae in Jiangxi to do the bamboo artisan, stay at night in a local dragon temple, see the wall bamboo 籀 shining, that the spirit of the dragon. At that time, coincuding with the rebellion of the Long Hair Army, the locals fled, and the two brothers were also very afraid, so they made a wish on the dragon hoop, praying for the two people to return home safely. Two people with the dragon hoop boat home, the way encountered strong winds and waves, two people quickly pray to the dragon hoop, an instant calm. Two people go home smoothly, want to zarong lantern also wish. But the two families were too poor to light the lamp, so they went to ask the chief. However, Pei is a small family name, patriarch can do nothing. That night, Pei Shi brother sudden eye disease, pain is hard to stop, medicine stone has no spirit. the patriarch came to visit with his people, and suddenly the dragon hoop hanging on the wall shone again, and everyone was surprised, and the local horse believed in the dragon God for a long time, people believed that it was the dragon spirit. Live with Hu Jia Ao Hu and Pei is nephew uncle relationship, Hu is the big name, heard this matter and Pei discussed, by the two names together to build a temple lamp, worship the dragon. "Xiao Jia 'ao Xiao and Bao Jialong Zhou and Peihu two family names are in-law, heard of this also joined in, the three lantern will be formed. " [15] the last Lantern Festival, the Tujia 'ao Lantern Festival, has been lost for a long time, and there are no local records of the Tujia 'ao Lantern Festival. So, its origin, for the time being, is unknown. 4.2 Rheology

Everything develops in the flow, and the washing Horse lantern Festival is no exception. There are three main ways to wash a horse lantern.

One is the flow of materials. the flow of making materials, there are two. One is the flow of the lamp paper. In the beginning, the dragon body was made of coarse cloth. Later, with the development of society, people thought that this kind of dragon lantern was too simple and not very ornamental. So, the coarse cloth into colored silk. After entering the 21st century, people have added a layer of shiny shimmering pieces to the colorful silk of the dragon lantern to add to the beauty of the dragon lantern. In addition, the lantern paper, has been using paper-cut, colored paper, etc., there is no obvious change. the second is the flow of the lantern wick. From the Qing Dynasty to the 1980s, lantern wicks were kerosene lamps, and rich families used candle wicks. Then, with the process of industrialization, the light bulb was invented and gradually popularized. Washing horse lantern wick, also naturally replaced the candle with electric light bulb, making the lantern, much brighter than before. In the 21st century, because incandescent lamps and LED lamps were invented and widely used, the wick of the horse lantern was updated again. Since then, in the night of the lantern tour, the lantern team is like three fire dragons in the sky, underground and water, giving people a visual and emotional shock.

The second is the change of parade form. In the past, after the lanterns were made, they were tied to bamboo poles and pillars in a prescribed order: first, the white horse opened the way, followed by "headlights", "scattered lanterns" and traditional folk programs; Secondly, take the "middle head lamp", "loose lamp" and "ground story"; Then, go "small head lamp", "loose lamp" and square array; Finally, "dragon lantern" first. Before the 21st century, these lights were all carried by villagers in parades. This not only costs a lot of manpower, but also easily causes the lantern to be damaged during the parade. After the 21st century, with the increasing prosperity of people's lives and the rapid development and popularization of science and technology, villagers will carry light loose lamps in their hands to parade; A small number of mediumsized lanterns, the bottom of the installation of rollers, rolling forward to swim; the remaining large lanterns were placed on small and large vehicles for swimming lanterns. This kind of borrowing the power of science and technology to change the old lantern form, to a large extent, reduce the damage to the elaborate lantern parade process, and also facilitate the villagers to swim the lamp.

The third is the change of lantern style. the evolution of the lantern style is constantly evolving according to the changes of the era background. the lantern originated in the Qing Dynasty, because of the belief in the dragon, so the style is only one kind of dragon lantern. Later, according to the animal signs, people imitated the shapes of the 12 zodiac animals and made corresponding zodiac lamps. To the end of the Qing Dynasty, according to the shape of the "melon", people made the meaning of the "golden melon lamp". At the same time, according to the legend of the divine beast Qilin, it made the "Qilin sending child lamp" which means good luck and brings children to people, and the "Lian Lian has fish lamp" which means a happy and happy life. the evolution of these lanterns is mainly dominated by people's aspirations for good luck and good luck, which express people's yearning for a better life.

5. CHARACTERISTICS AND VALUE OF HORSE LANTERN WASHING

"Existence is value. " The horse lantern will go through more than 300 years of wind and rain, and naturally has its unique survival characteristics and value.

5.1 Features

5.1.1 Uniqueness

The uniqueness of horse lantern washing is mainly reflected in two aspects.

First, the production is unique. the production of traditional horse-washing lanterns can be roughly divided into three kinds according to their different forms of expression. One is the use of carving, paper-cutting and other techniques, made some lanterns; the second is the use of twigs, painting, paper-cutting and other techniques to make a variety of animalstyle lanterns; the third is to tie people into (dress up as) various images of characters, performing various stories (called land stories). Second, the gameplay is unique. the unique

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way to wash the horse lantern is mainly reflected in the swim lamp link. When swimming, first walk the white horse lamp, then "walk" headlights, ten to twenty "scattered lights", and then walk "carrying pavilion", "stilts", "Lianxiang", "playing flower drum" and so on; Then go "middle head lamp", ten to twenty "loose lamp", and then go "color lotus boat", "clamshell essence", "big head package", "beggar married woman" and other stories; Then go "small headlights", ten to twenty "loose lights", and then go rolling "twelve zodiac lights", "waist drum team", "flower team" and other square formations; Finally, "dragon lantern". [15]

5.1.2 Custom

The custom of horse lantern washing is mainly reflected in two aspects.

First, it is rich in local customs. the local customs of horse washing are mainly reflected in religious belief, sacrifice and blessing. These customs are also the basis for the rise of horse lantern washing. This is because, due to the inheritance of old customs, horse washing people are used to using different kinds of lanterns to pray to the gods, praying for good weather, good crops, happy life and so on. the second is to hybridity custom activities. the parade of the Lantern Festival is not only a swim lamp, but also a blend of "carrying pavilion" "stilts" "Lian Xiang", etc., and other regional customs activities, mixed with the "color lotus boat", "clamshell fine", "big head package", "beggar married woman" and other regional stories, marching together.

5.2 Value

5.2.1 Cultural value

There are three main cultural values of horse lantern washing.

One is the cultural value of "common karma". "Mr. Liang Qichao said: 'Culture, the human heart can be released from the valuable common karma also. This statement expresses the basic meaning of culture, that is, culture is human-centered, and only what is created by people can be called culture. " [16] the horse washing lantern will continue to be inherited, and the "common karma" has profound accumulation and far-reaching cultural value. Second, the value of education. Intangible cultural heritage Horse lantern washing, belongs to the national traditional sports. "In different historical periods, traditional national sports, either as the subject of education or as one of the contents of education, have a real educational function" [17]. It can trigger the unity and sense of identity between people. Third, entertainment value. When the horse lantern parade, a variety of dazzling lanterns, not only ornamental, but also for the Lantern Festival added a bit of joy, very entertaining.

5.2.2 Economic value

There are two main economic values of horse lantern washing.

First, we will promote tourism development. Nowadays, the horse washing lantern will gradually become a local cultural symbol, and the launch of a joint ticket discount model with the scenic spots around the horse washing can attract tourists to play and promote the development of local tourism. Second. promote economic development. the development of local tourism can promote foreign investment in the Lantern Festival. We can take the opportunity to inject the culture of the Lantern Festival into the business, and use the traffic of the Lantern Festival to promote the common development of business and culture. the two promote each other, mutual benefit and win-win, and it will continue to be a virtuous circle, and the economy will naturally improve.

6.THE WASHING HORSE LANTERN WILL INHERIT THE STATUS QUO AND DIFFICULTIES

6.1 Inheritance Status

Horse Lantern Washing Association, since the approval of Hubei Province level intangible cultural heritage in 2013, two to three years, has established the Horse lantern Washing Association, and participated in various competitions, but also published books about the Horse lantern washing association. However, this good development trend lasted only a few short years. According to Zhou Qiang, the municipal inheritor of the Lantern Festival, in 2016, the Lantern Festival was suspended due to lack of funding. In 2017, due to the outcry of the villagers, the Lantern Festival was held again. In the past, it was because of funding problems, but now there is a new problem of "inheritance". At present, according to field investigations, the status quo of inheritance is mainly reflected in the

following three aspects.

First, the protection consciousness is not strong. the local villagers in Xiema town, Xishui County have not strong awareness of lantern culture protection. According to the field investigation, the square of the Lantern Festival in Zima Town has been left idle, and the bronze statues of the twelve zodiac animals built before have not been properly protected. In addition, the local intangible cultural heritage folklore Hall and the lantern preservation room of the washing horse Culture Station, although they were built in the early stage, due to long-term no cleaning and maintenance, they were covered with dust and cobwebs, and the lanterns were also slightly damaged. This shows that the protection of local lanterns is not strong. the power of inheritance is Second, insufficient. According to Zhou Qiang, a municipal inheritor, the Horse Lantern Washing Association was set up in 2012 and 2013, with Zhou Jinhong, secretary of the Party branch in Shamma Fan Village, serving as its president. the backbone of the association is mainly composed of inheritors and a few older generation craftsmen, and the number of inheritors is far from enough. In addition, the inheritance of the Lantern Festival can not only rely on the older generation, but also need young people to inject fresh blood and strengthen the inheritance force. Third, the propaganda is not enough. the Horse Lantern Washing Club is basically only known by local people, nearby villagers and a few people and researchers who love lanterns, and few others know about the Horse Lantern washing club. According to the survey, the vast majority of Huanggang people (except for the town of washing horses and neighboring counties and towns) do not know the horse washing Lantern Festival. This shows that the publicity work of the horse washing Lantern Association is not well done, resulting in the financing of the lantern and the inheritance of the lantern.

6.2 Inheritance Dilemma

Horse lantern washing will inherit difficulties, there are three main.

One is insufficient government support. First of all, the government's funding for provincial intangible cultural heritage should not only be allocated to provincial non-genetic inheritors, but also to projects. Secondly, although the government has issued laws and regulations on the protection and development of intangible cultural heritage, they are only formal and have not been implemented in practice. Thirdly, the Government only has its own regulations for a small number of intangible cultural heritage, while there are no relevant regulations for intangible cultural heritage such as the washing Horse lantern Festival. In addition, in the annual work deployment and plan of the provincial and municipal cultural stations and the Cultural and Tourism Bureau, there is little about the development and inheritance of the horse Lantern Washing Association. Horsewashing Lantern Festival also belongs to the intangible cultural heritage of sports. Therefore, "we need to increase support for sports policies and regulations, promote the development of the industry, sports and promote the popularization and development of sports programs. " [18] It will also greatly promote the inheritance of horse washing lanterns. Second, there is a shortage of inheritance funds. For a long time, the inheritance funds of the Lantern Association have only been raised by local people, which is difficult to attract investment, resulting in a temporary shortage of funds. According to Zhou Qiang, a municipal inhertor, the president of the Horse Washing Lantern Association will use the money allocated by the government every year to make lanterns in the association. With this amount of money, if you want to inherit the Lantern Festival, it is certainly not enough. To this end, the inheritors will often post money, and sometimes they will go to the town of Zema to raise money. Even so, due to the large supplies of lanterns, and the price of materials every year, coupled with the former free manpower, it has become necessary to pay a certain amount of compensation, and the interpretation of the "story" also needs to ask another person to perform. These costs, they add up to hundreds of thousands. Making it harder to wash the lantern every year. the third is the fault of inheritors. Intangible cultural heritage has a universal characteristic fragility, easy to be lost or extinct, and the washing Horse lantern Festival is no exception. the reason is because of the lack of inheritors and the small audience. the inheritors of the

existing horse-washing lantern club are all old people. According to the field investigation, one inheritor passed away last year, and the remaining inheritors are all old and frail, and the younger generation does not have talents who can bear the burden of inheritance, making the inheritance of the Horse Lantern Washing Association face the dilemma of discontinuity and generation.

7. THE LIVING INHERITANCE PATH OF THE WASHING HORSE LANTERN FESTIVAL FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE COMMUNITY OF HUMAN DESTINY

Nowadays, "Building a community with a shared future for mankind" is the main theme of world development. "Each beauty has its own beauty, the beauty of beauty, beauty and sharing" is the common demand of people around the world. Under this trend, following the theory of "community of human destiny", inheriting and developing the Horse Washing and Lantern Festival is unstoppable.

7.1 Adhere to dialogue and consultation, and build a peaceful living inheritance environment

Inheritance and Lantern washing will actively engage in dialogue with the government and villagers, clarify the causes of the dilemma, negotiate the solution to the living state inheritance, and build a peaceful living state inheritance environment. There are two specific measures.

First, adhere to dialogue and consultation with the government to build a harmonious living inheritance policy environment. Communicate and negotiate with relevant government staff, formulate scientific and reasonable investment policies, change the limit on the number of recommended provincial inheritors, formulate policies and measures to encourage and support local colleges and universities to set up elective courses of intangible cultural heritage such as horse washing and Lantern Festival, guide qualified primary and secondary schools to set up handicraft courses of intangible cultural heritage such as horse washing and Lantern Festival, and promote the formation of a harmonious and dynamic inheritance policy environment. In order to improve young people's cognition of excellent traditional

culture, intangible cultural heritage can be "passed down from generation to generation in cultural identity and cultural creation, and continue to develop" [19]. the second is to insist on dialogue and consultation with villagers to build a harmonious living inheritance social environment. Communicate and negotiate with the villagers of lantern art inheritance, protect provincial non-genetic inheritors over the age of 70, and speed up the rescue recording and video work. Negotiate with the villagers of the town to organize the horse washing Lantern Festival, as well as financing. Starting from two months before the Lantern Festival, we will communicate and negotiate with each family and villagers to organize the lantern fair, see how much can be raised, how to use the money reasonably, what specifications can be purchased for a lantern fair, and build a harmonious living and inheriting social environment.

7.2 Adhere to cooperation and sharing, and create a prosperous dynamic inheritance scene

The living inheritance of the horse Lantern washing conference can not only rely on their own, but also borrow the ship to go out to sea, solve problems through wisdom, and create a prosperous living inheritance scene. There are two specific measures.

One is to cooperate and share with villagers to create a thriving living inheritance scene. This cooperative sharing is divided into two levels. On the first floor, cooperate with the villagers to make lights. Invite the inheritors of the lamp art to the town, led by the Horse Washing Lantern Association, organize the villagers to gather together, learn and share the lamp making skills, and widely popularize, and create a prosperous living inheritance scene. Second, cooperate with the villagers to get rich together. the villagers should work together to build the brand of horse lantern washing. the use of some gimmicks, such as "Shen Hongguang, former deputy director of the Hubei Provincial Department of Culture, gave a high appraisal of the pomp of the horse washing Lantern Festival, 'the fifteenth day of the first month, please go to the horse washing Lantern Festival'" and so on, and so on, the use of the media to widely publicize the reputation of the Lantern Festival washing horse Lantern Festival. Attract tourists to play, promote local

economic development, and create a thriving living heritage scene. the second is to cooperate and share with the tourism industry to create a dynamic and prosperous inheritance pattern. According to the field investigation, the scenic spots around Xishui County have perfect facilities. For this reason, the Lantern Club can cooperate with the tourism industry to launch a concessionalticket model. Moreover, the horse lantern can try to break the previous performance time, in addition to the Lantern Festival, it can also be combined with the tourist season. Of course, the premise is to separate from the Lantern Festival prayer and sacrifice, on the basis of the original lantern meeting process, simplify and remove the fitness, entertainment poor part, and commercialize it. This can not only promote the development of the local tourism economy, but also increase the fame of the horse lantern washing association, cast the lantern brand, and form a prosperous living inheritance pattern.

7.3 Adhere to exchanges and mutual learning and promote innovative development of dynamic inheritance

Different countries, regions and nations have their own unique civilizations, and respect for the civilizations of other countries, regions and nations is a prerequisite for exchanges and mutual learning among world civilizations and joint progress of mankind. There are two specific measures to adhere to exchanges and mutual learning and promote innovative development through dynamic inheritance.

The first is to communicate and learn from each other with the villagers to promote the diversified development of the living state inheritance. At present, the Horse Lantern Washing Club has a total of five teams, distributed in five different villages, led by the Horse Lantern Washing Association. It is possible to organize the heads of the five teams of branch lantern clubs regularly to introduce and exchange the management, inheritance, development, innovation and other situations of their own lantern clubs, learn from each other, and promote the active inheritance and diversified development of the Horse washing Lantern Club. the second is to exchange and learn from each other to promote the diversified development of the active state inheritance. In addition to the

exchange and mutual learning between their five teams, the Horse Washing Lantern Club can also take the initiative to go out and exchange and mutual learning with other lantern clubs, in order to discover the new inheritance and development direction of the horse Washing Lantern Club. For example, with the Yu Garden lantern fair, Qinhuai lantern, Chaozhou folk lantern Fair and other similar lantern fair, lantern exchange and mutual learning, learn from each other, learn from innovation, and promote the diversified development of its living state inheritance.

7.4 Adhere to green and low-carbon, and form an environmentally friendly living mode of inheritance

Adhere to green and low-carbon, in an environmentally friendly way, live state inheritance of horse lantern washing, there are two specific measures.

First, the lamp material is green and environmentally friendly, and the living inheritance method of ecological civilization is practiced. To carry forward the horse Lantern washing, we should take the concept of "community of human destiny" as the concept, adhere to green environmental protection, and practice ecological civilization. This requires the production of lanterns, to do two insistence. First, we must adhere to the green lighting materials. Although, we can use the achievements of modern science and technology to replace the old things; However, it does not mean that the ecological environment can be destroyed at will, or we must adhere to the green and environmentally friendly living inheritance method, and try to use the original paper rope, bamboo strips, colored paper, paste, etc., green and environmentally friendly materials. Then, after the end of the lamp, the collective burning of the lamp can do as little as possible to pollute the environment. Second, we must continue to turn waste into treasure and recycle it. For example, dragon lamps and headlamps, only need to repair the broken place before use, you can recycle every year, which is much more environmentally friendly than lanterns made of plastic, acrylic plate and allov. Second. lantern fuel energy conservation and emission reduction, the practice of low-carbon consumption reduction of the active mode of inheritance. the

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replacement of lantern wick fuel is the main source of energy saving and emission reduction. In the Qing Dynasty, well-to-do families used kerosene as lantern fuel, and ordinary people used other oils as lantern fuel. During the period of the Republic of China, people with good families used candles as lantern fuel; Ordinary people use kerosene as fuel for lanterns. Kerosene lamps and candles are weak and release carbon monoxide and carbon dioxide during combustion. In this way, not only is the effect of the lantern parade not so shocking, but energy conservation and emission reduction have not been achieved, causing certain pollution to the air, environment and ecology. After the reform and opening up, gradually began to use lights as fuel, flower lamps become brighter, and the ornamental value of the tour lamp is enhanced. However, the consumption of batteries increases, and the batteries thrown away at will still pollute the environment. Now, most of the people have replaced the lights with LED lights, and have tried their best to achieve "small consumption and zero emissions", effectively practicing the low-carbon consumption reduction of the living mode of inheritance.

8. CONCLUSION

Horse lantern washing will have a strong local folk culture color, after more than 300 years of inheritance system, gradually change. complete, development trend, increasingly good. However, with the rapid transformation of our society, the development of the washing Horse lantern Festival is not satisfactory, and there are problems such as insufficient government support, fault inheritors, and shortage of inheritance funds. In response to these disadvantages, the active inheritance path of "adhere to dialogue and consultation, peaceful living inheritance build а environment", "adhere to cooperation and sharing, create a prosperous living inheritance scene", "adhere to exchanges and mutual learning, promote the innovative development of living inheritance", "adhere to green and low-carbon, form an environmentally friendly living inheritance mode" is proposed. This not only has practical guiding significance for promoting the inheritance and development of the horse washing Lantern Association,

prospering local culture and thriving local tourism economy. It is also useful for the inheritance and development of other traditional folk sports activities in China.

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Abstract: Introduction: In the 21st century, when globalization is intensifying, thousands of Chinese people go abroad to study or live overseas. They inevitably face the conflict between noumenon culture and diversity of heterogeneous cultures. the resulting cultural adaptation barriers have become the key problems that must be solved in the multicultural exchange and adjustment under the background of globalization. Therefore, how to intervene the cross-cultural adaptation of overseas students, especially those who need to teach Chinese as the second language, with psychological capital has become an important topic. Research objects and methods: And with the help of the crosscultural adaptation model of psychological capital, we can find out the ways to intervene the cross-cultural adaptation of overseas students with psychological capital. Results: Based on the survey, the Chinese students in the the National University of Malaysia have different degrees of acculturation problems. 90% of the students can feel the cultural difference and culture shock between the two countries. Of these, 10% of them had difficulty adjusting to studying in Malaysia. Female students are nearly the same as male students in adaptation, and there is no obvious difference between them. Conclusion: the cross-cultural adaptation model based on psychological capital points out that the crosscultural adaptation of foreign students in China is the result of individual environment interaction. To intervene in the cross-cultural adaptation of foreign students and guide them to improve their self-efficacy, hope, optimism and resilience at the individual level; At the management level, we should strengthen the primary prevention, integrate resources, and

achieve the key breakthrough in the promotion of psychological capital, so as to ultimately promote the sound development of crosscultural adaptation of foreign students.

1. INTRODUCTION

The trend of economic globalization not only makes the economic and political exchanges between countries more and more close, but also makes the educational exchanges between countries more and more frequent. and the trade in educational services is increasingly developed, which has brought about a fever of international study abroad. As envoys of cultural exchanges, international students have laid down human capital and cultural capital for the coordinated development of the two sides and further deepened international cooperation. At present, there are more than one million students studying abroad all over the world, and the number of international students has reached an unprecedented scale and leapfrog development. Studies have shown that international students studying abroad are a special group with more mental diseases. Their social and cultural difficulties are at a medium level, and their average score of depression is higher than that of the Chinese norm (Lei Longyun et al., 2004). At the same time, foreign students are also prone to compulsion, interpersonal sensitivity and anxiety (Wu Zhigang et al., 2010). This crosscultural maladjustment not only affects the development of foreign students themselves, but also leads to social instability and contradictions between countries. Therefore,

it is very necessary to carry out primary prevention and intervention on the crosscultural adaptation of foreign students.

The study of cross-cultural adaptation originated in the United States in the 20th century. Intercultural adaptation refers to the choice and adjustment of individual psychology and behavior to the change of cultural situation. the adjustment process is affected by various variables at the individual level and social level and presents diversified results. (Zhu Guohui et al., 2011) It is widely recognized that Ward C (2001) divides crosscultural adaptation socio-cultural into adaptation and psychological adaptation, and Black's three-dimensional classification of general adaptation, working adaptation and communicative adaptation (Wang Lijuan, 2011). Cross cultural adaptation is a complex process. At present, there are many models of cross-cultural adaptation proposed by the academic community, and research focuses on many explicit influencing factors. However, most models seem to regard cultural adaptation as a passive behavior, developing many more negative concepts, such as cultural shock, alienation, etc., and pay less attention positive to potential, and integrated psychological factors. Therefore, from the perspective of positive psychology, it is of great practical significance for international students to explore what kind of people they want to be in the culture of the host country and how to adjust to the life of the host country.

2. SUBJECTS AND METHODS 2.1 Study setting

Horwits et al. (1986) defined foreign language anxiety as: "Because of the uniqueness of the language learning process, learners have an obvious anxiety about self-consciousness, beliefs, feelings and behaviors related to language learning". learning classroom anxiety is a kind of negative emotion, such as self doubt, uneasiness, tension, etc. learning anxiety, like other foreign language learning anxiety, has a negative impact on learning performance, learning process, test results, communication ability, self-esteem, selfconfidence, etc. Anxiety is an important affective factor affecting language learning. Most research results show that anxiety has a negative impact on learning, mainly including

some bad emotions that hinder learning, such as fear, fear, etc. the influence of these emotional factors on learning can not be ignored, it directly affects students' learning behavior and results. the participation of positive emotions will produce good teaching results. On the contrary, negative emotions such as anxiety, inhibition, depression, doubt, etc. will affect the normal play of learning potential. In addition to itself, students' anxiety about learning in higher vocational colleges also comes from their own emotional barriers. A considerable number of students have "Korean learning anxiety". Therefore, it is an important prerequisite to improve the quality of teaching to solve the emotional problems of students' "Korean learning anxiety" on learning.

The theory of psychological capital extends organizational behavior from and management, providing a new perspective for the study of cross-cultural adaptation. the emergence of the concept of psychological capital is closely related to human capital and positive psychology (He Weifeng et al., 2011). Positive psychological capital is a kind of positive psychology displayed by individuals in the process of growth and development, emphasizing "who are you" and "what do you want to be". Psychological capital is not only affected by environmental factors, but also closely related to individual psychological and behavioral variables (Wang Yanfei et al., 2007). It has a significant regulatory effect on cultural intelligence and cross-cultural adaptation of foreign students (Li Xiaoyan et al., 2012). In view of the problems existing in the current cross-cultural adaptation of overseas students, this paper intends to explore the cross-cultural adaptation model of overseas students in the form of questionnaires from the perspective of positive psychology, based on the theory of psychological capital, in order to inspire the host country to help overseas students improve their self-efficacy, cultivate optimism, hope, resilience and other positive psychological qualities, thus making the intervention of cross-cultural adaptation more feasible and dynamic.

Anxiety is an important emotional obstacle for college students in the process of foreign language learning. Foreign language learners

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sometimes have anxiety in the process of mastering listening, speaking, reading and writing abilities(*HORWTTZ E et al. 1986*). By analyzing the relationship between learning effectiveness and anxiety of college students and the causes of learning anxiety, the author hopes to give some inspiration to the cultivation of the psychological quality of college students' health.

Anxiety is one of the abnormal emotions, also known as psychological abnormality, which refers to the emotional state of nervousness and fear formed by individuals' failure to achieve the expected goals or overcome obstacles(*Wang Qi et al. 2003*), which frustrates their self-esteem and selfconfidence, and increases their sense of failure and guilt. General behavioral anxiety refers to a kind of reaction similar to worry and fear when people are under certain pressure or their self-esteem is threatened. It is a kind of self deprecating and self doubting cognition.

Foreign language learning anxiety, different from general behavioral anxiety, is a kind of anxiety in a special situation, which is directly related to the use of language. It is a unique phenomenon for students in foreign language learning. It comes into being in the process of foreign language learning, and is manifested in the students' low evaluation of their foreign language communicative competence(Xin Ling et al. 2004). Foreign scholars have made a thorough study of foreign language learning anxiety, and regard foreign language learning anxiety as a significant self-consciousness, belief and emotional complex related to classroom language learning; There are also those who define language anxiety as tension and fear that have a special relationship with context (including speaking, listening and learning). In the process of learning, the anxiety of college students about learning is inevitable, but because learning anxiety will have a negative impact on college students' personal learning, and even have a serious impact on the whole teaching process, based on this, we should recognize the relationship between learning anxiety and learning effect, so as to find out the coping strategies of vocational college students' learning anxiety(Zhang Baoyan et al. 1996), Mobilize students' internal motivation for learning, improve students' enthusiasm for learning,

cultivate students' interest in learning foreign languages, and improve their academic performance.

2.2 Design

Taking the National University of Malaysia as an example, the author conducted field research and data statistics on Chinese students in the university for nearly a year. the National University of Malaysia is a four-year public university. Founded in 1890, it ranks 83rd in the academic ranking of the United States. There are more than 25000 students. 4500 graduate students, 16% of whom are foreign students, including 407 Chinese students. the number of Chinese students studying abroad is increasing every year, up 57% in five years, and there is a trend of further expansion. Among the 407 Chinese students, there are 150 women, accounting for 37%, and 257 men, accounting for 63%. the proportion of men is significantly higher than that of women. the age of international students ranges from 16 to 45 years old, with an average age of 26 years. 208 students are mainly aged between 20 and 30 years old, accounting for 69%. 52 students are over 30 years old, accounting for 13%, and 147 students are under 20 years old, accounting for 17%.

The purpose is to understand the basic situation of Chinese students in NUS, including whether they can adapt to study, life and other aspects. To find out the factors that produce cultural differences. the author has referred to the domestic and foreign data and some famous mental health measurement questionnaires. Combined with the in-depth interviews of nearly 70 foreign students, a cross-cultural adaptation Questionnaire for Chinese students was designed about the cultural differences between China and Malaysia. the questionnaire consists of 42 questions, including true/false questions and multiple choice questions. Criteria for scoring: 100 points for complete adaptation, 75 points for basic adaptation, 50 points for a little discomfort, and 0 points for complete inability to adapt. Some projects adopt Likert (et al. 2005) 5-point scoring method, the specific implementation steps are generally as follows: Design about the students' study, life and other relevant adaptation problems. the answers to these questions were highly directional, either positive or negative, and were divided into five levels: strongly agree, agree, unsure, disagree, strongly disagree.

All statements are divided into two categories: Statements of positive attitude (such as "I am well adapted to life in Malaysia") and statements of negative attitude (for example "I am not adapted to life in Malaysia"). And give each answer a score. the scoring method for positive attitude statements is: Strongly agree - 5 points, agree - 4 points, uncertain - 3 points, disagree - 2 points, strongly disagree - 1 point; Negative sentences are scored in the opposite way.

Then a random sample of respondents was selected. They were also asked to rate their responses according to their own opinions.

Make a scale, and the scale is composed of sentences with strong directivity. After the questionnaire is made, its use method is: Let the foreign students answer each item, then convert it into scores, and add them up. In this way, the attitude scores of each foreign student can be obtained. If the scores of all respondents are averaged, the overall attitude of the respondents to the evaluation item can be obtained.

The questionnaire consists of 3 parts. the first part is about the basic information of the students. the questions in the second part mainly involve two directions, the crosscultural field and the mental health field. Among them, the latter problem design includes three aspects. To understand the understanding of foreign students on Malaysian culture and the differences between Chinese and Malaysian cultures. Cultural adaptation experience, that is, whether the foreign students have experience of contacting or experiencing different cultures. the field of mental health includes the occurrence of positive or negative emotions, behavioral expression, psychological experience, physiological reactions and other changes in the process of cultural adaptation, as well as the overall expectations for the future of studying abroad. the third section focuses on the study and life of foreign students, that is, cultural adaptation and cultural adaptation methods adopted. Consider from the aspects of external environment adaptation, social relationship adaptation, academic adaptation, etc.

Questionnaire method: Questionnaire distribution, in-depth interview, online test, etc. Questionnaires and in-depth interviews were mainly conducted in student fraternities, Confucius Institutes, libraries, classrooms, restaurants, dormitories and other places where foreign students gathered. A total of 532 written and online questionnaires were distributed, and 428 valid questionnaires were recovered, with an effective recovery rate of 80%. Among them, 56 foreign students participated in both written questionnaires and online surveys.

According to the statistics of 301 valid samples, Cronbach ' the coefficient of sa is 0.876. This shows that the internal reliability of the scale is high, and it has high applicability for Chinese college students(YOUNG et al. 1986). Analyzing the descriptive statistics of 301 subjects' learning anxiety scores, the minimum value is 34, the maximum value is 163, the average is 95.33, and the standard deviation is 18.92. Compared with the results of similar studies at home and abroad, it can be seen that the FLCAS scores are relatively close. However, when the subjects were learners in the first year, the anxiety index was significantly higher(ONWUEGBUZIE et al. 2000).

Also noteworthy is Wang Caikang's research results: the average FLCAS score of the subjects he calculated was only 83.9, much lower than the results of similar studies. This may not be "related to the long foreign language learning experience of Chinese college students" explained by Wang Caikang, but due to the data distortion caused by their translation errors(*Li Yibing et al. 2004*).

Although this study and foreign studies have reached relatively close results on the overall level of college students' foreign language anxiety, it is worth noting that the subjects in the two foreign studies are both first-year foreign language learners, while the subjects in this study have at least 7 years of learning experience. It is generally believed that as learners become familiar with the target language, the longer their foreign language learning experience is, the lower their anxiety level will be. However, Chinese college students who have studied for many years have the same degree of anxiety as American beginners, that is, as far as the absolute value of learning anxiety is concerned, there is no significant difference between Chinese college students and American college students; In addition, in terms of its relative value, (Huang Qiang et al. 2003) the learning anxiety index of Chinese college students is higher than that of American college students. According to specific analysis, there may be the following reasons: First, there is a strong test pressure. Although American college students also have to take various forms of foreign language proficiency tests, none of them has the harshness of the Chinese Level Examination. Despite several reforms, most Chinese universities still link the level examination with the degree; (HORWTTZ E et al. 1991) At the same time, the passing rate of grade examination is an important indicator to assess teachers' performance, and teachers have to put pressure on students. Employers also often measure the foreign language level of college graduates based on a paper of language grade certificates. With the emergence of the problem of "difficult employment", college students are putting pressure on themselves to increase the weight Second, of employment. inappropriate teaching concepts and methods. (Wang Caikang et al. 2003) The "full room" teaching method still prevails in foreign language classrooms. Teachers ignore the cultivation of students' interest in learning, the interaction between teachers and students, and the creation of language situations. Too frequent and severe error correction often makes learners anxious and afraid of using language, which is particularly prominent in oral teaching.

In addition, in order to verify the relationship between foreign language anxiety and foreign language learning effect(*Lei Xiao et al. 2004*), this study conducted Pearson correlation analysis based on the scores of subjects' proficiency test and their anxiety scores. the result is r=-0.485, p<0.001, which shows that foreign language anxiety is negatively correlated with test scores. This is consistent with the results of most studies at home and abroad. However, some scholars have pointed out that anxiety does not always hinder foreign language learning. As for the relationship between anxiety and learning effect, the "inverted U-shaped curve" proposed by

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Jacques and Dodson is widely accepted in the field of educational psychology: A moderate level of arousal is conducive to the completion of the task. However (Pi Liansheng et al. 2002), it also points out that a higher wake-up level is conducive to the efficiency of simple tasks, while a lower wake-up level is more conducive to the efficiency of complex tasks. In order to explore the influence of different levels of anxiety on learning (H ORWITZ E K et al. 1990), this study divided the subjects into three groups: low anxiety group, moderate anxiety group, and high anxiety group. the total foreign language anxiety score and test scores were analyzed respectively. the statistical analysis of 301 subjects' total scores of foreign language anxiety shows that the total average score of foreign language anxiety is 95.33, (ARNOLD J et al. 2000) and the standard deviation is 18.92. the subjects were divided into three groups: the total average score of low foreign language anxiety group was less than 95.33-18.92, that is, less than 76; the total average score of the high foreign language anxiety group was more than 95.33+18.92, that is, more than 114; the subjects between the two groups (76~114 points) constitute a moderate foreign language anxiety group.

The SPSS was applied to analyze the scores of items in the questionnaire, and to find out the difference between the two groups. the results indicate that 91% of the respondents are able to sense the cultural difference and influence of Malaysian culture. Among them, 12 per cent of the international students do not fit to live in the country's colleges. 68% of the international students said they were moderately unfit for the life and culture of the National University of Malaysia, and 20% of

the international students said they were relatively suitable, as shown in Table 1 below. In Malaysia, the time periods for foreign students to experience cultural shock and cultural adjustment are as follows: 1 week (12%); 1 month (23%); 3 months (47%); 3 months (28%). the results show that 9 percent of the students can get used to living in Malaysia in 3 months, 52 percent take 3 to 6 months, and 27 percent take 6 to 1 year. Twelve percent of students need more than one year. In the first 3 months of their arrival in Malaysia, 70 percent of the Chinese students found it hard to adapt to culture. By means of the questionnaire and deep interview, it is discovered that the students have positive feelings of curiosity, enthusiasm and selfconfidence in the course of adapting to culture (which is special in the new era). Starting from the 3rd month, the proportion of those with moderate maladjustment is increasing, but the proportion of those with more maladjustment has declined, which may be due to the conclusion of their mental honeymoon and the start of the crisis. Since the 6th to the 1st year, there has been a big change in the adjustment of the culture of the students. the proportion of those who don't adapt has fallen dramatically, but those who are more adaptable have gone up in a straight line. This indicates that the majority of the students have successfully passed through the crisis, and are now in the stage of cultural adjustment. All in all, nearly all of the students have increased their ability to adapt. There are, of course, some failures in the process of intercultural adaptation. Two percent of the students are very incompetent and decide to quit or transfer. Generally speaking, as time passes, about 88 percent of the students are able to successfully overcome the difficulty of cross-culture adaptation in their first year. Adaptation time is one of the most important factors that influence culture adaptability. Among them, the 3rd, 6th, 1st and 3rd are the most important transitions.

Pearson correlation analysis between anxiety index of different levels and test scores of college students shows that the higher the degree of anxiety, the greater the negative impact on test scores. It is worth noting that there is no significant difference between the anxiety index and the performance of the low level foreign language anxiety group, but it is negative. This is contrary to Huang Qiang's research conclusion, which shows that anxiety has no effect on foreign language learning under any circumstances. In fact, the positive correlation in the study of Huangqiang is not statistically significant.

Why does the "inverted U-shaped curve" proposed by Jacques and Dodson, which reveals the correlation between arousal level and learning effect, fail in foreign language learning? This problem must be analyzed from the characteristics of foreign language learning tasks. Yakes and Dodson put forward that "moderate arousal level is conducive to the completion of tasks", and pointed out that higher arousal level is conducive to the efficiency of simple tasks, while lower arousal level is more conducive to the improvement of the efficiency of complex tasks. Horwitz believes, "Anxiety can only be helpful for very simple learning tasks; For more complex learning, such as language learning, anxiety does not promote. Anxiety hinders learners' memory and thinking, inhibits their language potential, leads to their dull thinking and gradually loses their confidence and motivation in learning, their learning attitude tends to be negative, and their learning effect tends to decline. Therefore, the conclusion that there is a significant negative correlation between foreign language anxiety and foreign language learning effect conforms to the special law of foreign language learning, which indicates that FLCAS has a good predictive validity for foreign language achievement.




Fig1. Inner and Outer Factors Influencing Intercultural Adaptation

The main problems of foreign students lie in life (45%), learning (40%), social culture (48%), personal psychological adaptation (38%), social interpersonal relationship (68%) and many other aspects. the most prominent problem is social interpersonal communication, as shown in Figure 1 below. According to the data of the experimental study, the causes of learning anxiety of vocational college students are analyzed:

First, the low self-evaluation of students in higher vocational colleges has obvious characteristics of the times. Most of them are active in thinking, optimistic and confident, but they have a poor foundation in general cultural courses and are not interested in learning. Some students' cognitive and selfcontrol abilities become worse, and they deny their learning ability and even their intellectual ability, which makes them feel inferior. Negative self concern naturally has a negative impact on learning. A large number of vocational college students' distrust of their learning ability is a reflection of low selfevaluation, a synthesis of communication fear and negative evaluation fear(Deng Yuan J et al. 2004).

The second is the individual character of the students themselves. Introversion and extroversion directly affect learning. Extroverts tend to be lively, cheerful, warm, generous, informal, good at communication, emotional exposure, quick reaction, easy to adapt to changes in the environment, and do not mind the evaluation of others; Introverted people tend to take themselves as the starting point, deep and steady, cautious, thoughtful, slow in reaction, not good but at communication, adapt to environmental difficulties, pay attention to others' evaluation of themselves, always worry about what students think of themselves, afraid of being negatively evaluated by teachers and students. Under classroom teaching conditions, when teachers ask students to complete tasks contrary to their personality, they may become overly anxious and dare not speak in class, especially when speaking in front of teachers and students, they feel nervous and afraid of making mistakes, and avoid answering questions in class, which affects the improvement of learning quality.

The third is about the examination. the occurrence of examination anxiety is, on the one hand, because students do not master the language knowledge they should have and are

afraid of the anxiety caused by failing to pass the examination, on the other hand, because students are often worried about the anxiety caused by poor examination results, which in turn affects the normal performance of students in the examination. In classroom learning, students are almost always tested, so students often feel pressure and anxiety in this process.

Fourth, the form of classroom teaching activities, teaching activities and teaching methods, such as oral expression in front of the whole class and students, will cause more or less anxiety to most students. In class, when students have to speak to the whole class, especially when they are unprepared, it is one of the classroom activities that most easily cause students' anxiety. Although the studentcentered teaching model is now advocated, the reality is that teachers are still leading the classroom, and teachers will immediately correct students when they make mistakes. This form of communication between teachers and learners can easily cause anxiety among students.

Fifth, learning itself. Because is a language independent of the mother tongue, which involves not only different grammatical systems, but also different customs, ways of thinking, expression habits and values, some students are afraid of losing themselves in culture, which leads to anxiety.

4. DISCUSSION

Lysgard, who first investigated the temporal effects of cross-culture adaptation. Based on this model, Oberg classified the mental transformation and emotional adjustment of migrants or those who came to their home for the first time into four phases: Fresh phase, Honeymoon phase, Critical phase and Recovery phase. It is also one of the most widely recognized and representative claims in the culture adjustment theory to date. the results of the study suggest that after the "honeymoon period", foreign students usually feel pressure and have a stress state, and then go through a crisis period(Walsh E. 2010).

At present, cross-cultural scholars generally believe that the factors that affect the crosscultural adaptation of immigrants or travelers are mainly divided into external factors and internal factors (Chen Hui et al., 2003). Among them, external factors include: First, life changes: Different eating habits, pace of life, climate change, means of transportation, and living conditions in China and the West, including changes at the city level, such as the huge differences experienced by students who have been living in large cities in China when they came to small towns or villages abroad. Second, time factor: It refers to the impact of the length of intercultural adaptation on cultural adaptation. This study is mainly divided by the time difference of every three months until about one year. Third, social support: It is generally considered to be the most important and key factor in cultural adaptation, mainly from compatriots and local socio-cultural members. Fourth, cultural distance: It refers to the distance between the sojourner's mother culture and the local culture. Generally, scholars believe that the cultural distance between China and the West is greater than that between China and some Asian countries.

Professor Luthans F. (2004), former chairman of Malaysian Management Society, put forward the concept of psychological capital, summarized four elements and of psychological capital that meet the criteria for the selection of psychological capital elements, namely, the basic psychological strength of individuals and the psychological state defined by organizational behavior, which are positive, have a theoretical basis, can be measured and developed, and are highly related to performance. the cross-cultural adaptation model of international students based on the theory of psychological capital integrates various factors of psychological capital, pays attention to the potential and positive possibilities of international students' cross-cultural adaptation, and regards crosscultural adaptation as a process of individual active integration and self promotion, which provides some enlightenment for universities to promote the cross-cultural adaptation intervention of international students. First of all, from the object of view, we should not only pay attention to some foreign students who have suffered from the crisis of crosscultural adaptation, but also to those who have suffered not from cross-cultural maladjustment. Early prevention and active attention should be paid to the students who

adapt to the cross-cultural crisis, and the corresponding psychological capital emergency intervention mechanism can be launched as soon as possible; For students who have not yet had cultural maladjustment, should focus on promoting their we psychological development, and at the same time, we should monitor and extract experience, so as to provide successful examples for those who have maladjustment. Secondly, from the content, in addition to the combination intervention from the recognized psychological capital elements - self-efficacy, hope, optimism and resilience, we can further explore more comprehensive psychological capital intervention content from the control point, self-esteem and other elements. Finally, from the perspective of form, colleges and universities can help foreign students identify the resources they have at the individual level, and promote the development of their potential and cultural intelligence. At the organizational level, the management of the mental health education of foreign students is guided by positive psychology and focuses on improvement. the path of primary prevention - integrating resources - improving mental capital can be adopted, which is not only for individuals, but also has theoretical and practical significance for the management of the group of foreign students. This provides a new perspective for the construction of the physical health assistance system for overseas students, and ultimately promotes the sound development of cross-cultural adaptation of overseas students. Therefore, exploring the connotation, dimension and causality of foreign students' psychological capital at different levels is also a new direction for the future study of cross-cultural adaptation theory and practice.

As we all know, learning a second language is a complex and tedious process. When college students learn, they are often affected by many emotional factors, such as learners' personality characteristics, learning activities and teaching methods, cultural factors, and so on. Students' anxiety, learning motivation, selfconfidence and other non intellectual factors play a great role in students' learning. Teachers should actively explore, flexibly use various teaching methods, change the education mode of mandatory indoctrination and restraint, pay attention to students' speech and behavior, be good at finding anxious students in classroom, and take some targeted measures to minimize their classroom anxiety, Make students change from passive acceptance to active exploration of the process of active acquisition, self-development and self-improvement, so as to improve students' comprehensive quality, improve their learning ability and achieve the best teaching effect.

5. CONCLUSIONS

To sum up, the psychological problems of foreign students are not only an individual phenomenon, but also a problem related to family happiness, campus harmony and social stability. Studying abroad not only means independent growth for individuals, but also means challenges. Adaptation to the host country is equivalent to re socialization. Therefore, it is of great practical significance to improve the cross-cultural adaptation of foreign students. This paper only makes a preliminary discussion on the improvement of the positive psychological capital of foreign students, and brings it into the theoretical model of cross-cultural adaptation of foreign students, so that more scholars can pay attention to this group, effectively apply psychological capital intervention training to the mental health services of foreign students, solve the psychological confusion of the remaining students, and help them learn and grow more happily.

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Depressive Symptoms, Social Anxiety and Medical Coping Modes Among Hepatobiliary Surgery Patients as Basis for Preventive Strategy Program Development

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Abstract: This research examines depression, social anxiety, and coping strategies among hepatobiliary surgery patients to develop a targeted prevention program. the study uses a standardized questionnaire to explore these variables in relation to various patient characteristics amidst the growing need for surgical treatments for liver and gallbladder diseases. Results show strong links between depression, social anxiety, and coping styles, with high preoperative depression (19-37%) and prevalent postoperative social anxiety. Patients commonly use negative coping methods such as self-blame and avoidance. Based on these findings, an evidence-based preventive strategy is designed to cater to patients' unique psychological needs. improving mental health, treatment outcomes, and recovery after hepatobiliary surgeries.

1. INTRODUCTION

Hepatobiliary surgeries entail multifaceted physical and psychological trials for patients. Besides physical recovery, many encounter depression and social anxiety due to illness and treatment impacts. Their coping strategies significantly affect recovery and well-being. Understanding these psychological aspects and coping modes is vital for crafting targeted preventive strategies. Healthcare providers must identify patient-specific challenges to personalize interventions and enhance their quality of life. Thus, exploring the effects of depression, anxiety, and coping styles on patients necessitates a shift from one-way to two-way medical care, enabling tailored prevention and personalized services.

Medical coping style (also known as coping strategy or coping mechanism) refers to a coping style in the face of problems, as well as some behaviors adopted in this situation. the problems faced mainly refer to the unfavorable environment around them or collectively referred to as stressors. Such coping style will in turn affect the stress of individuals (nature and intensity). Furthermore, it has a certain degree of influence on the results of stress (Cai, et al., 2021; Huang, et al., 2020; Kurtses, et al., 2022; Liu, et al., 2022; Tokumitsu, et al., 2023), American scholar Leventhal first put forward the psychological concept of disease cognition (also known as disease perception). the coping style of patients in the face of disease will be affected by disease cognition. In this process, patients' cognition of disease will be further affected and indirectly influence to a certain extent, mainly positive promotion, and then further to the occurrence and development of the patient's disease.

2. DATA AND METHODS

This study randomly selected hepatobiliary surgery patients from two affiliated hospitals of Guangxi University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Participants provided informed consent and completed SDS, IAS, MCMQ, and other assessments. Statistical analysis using SPSS 25.0 was performed on the collected data to analyze depression, social anxiety, and coping styles, aiming to develop targeted prevention strategies.

3. RESULTS

Table 1 describes the social anxiety levels among 208 respondents. Respondents rated various statements regarding their feelings in social situations using a scale where higher scores indicate greater agreement with the statement. the items cover diverse scenarios such as attending informal parties, interacting with strangers, feeling confident in social interactions, and dealing with authority figures. the mean scores suggest that respondents generally experience mild levels of social anxiety (total mean score of 35.43). Most participants "agree a little" or exhibit a "medium level" of correspondence with items indicating anxiety in unfamiliar social settings, interacting with new people, or in professional contexts like job interviews. However, they tend to feel more relaxed in certain situations, such as talking to someone of the opposite sex or being around people different from themselves.

Table 2 presents data on the medical coping modes of the respondents. There are three identified subscales: Face (highest ranked with a mean of 2.94), Avoidance (ranked second with a mean of 2.13), and Yield (ranked third with a mean of 1.59). These scores reflect how frequently respondents employ different coping strategies when facing medical issues. the 'Face' mode indicates confronting the problem head-on, while 'Avoidance' represents evasion or sidestepping stressful medical situations, and 'Yield' suggests accepting the situation without resistance. As per the test instructions, there's no overall score for medical coping; instead, it highlights the most commonly used coping strategy among the respondents, which is the 'Face' mode. the ranking order provides insights into the relative preference for these coping mechanisms, with respondents tending to favor confrontation ('Face') over avoidance or yielding.

Future researchers could conduct longitudinal studies to unravel the dynamic interaction between mental health and the progression of hepatobiliary diseases.

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Study on Short-Term Load Forecasting of Power System Based on Wavelet Transform

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Abstract: Short-term load forecasting is of great significance to the operation and planning of power system. A high-precision load forecasting model is established by using wavelet transform, and the load curve is decomposed into high frequency and low frequency time series by wavelet decomposition. Then AR model is used to forecast the decomposed sub-sequences, and then the prediction results of each subsequence are reconstructed by wavelet to obtain the predicted value of short-term load. the validity of the proposed method is verified by comparing the short-term load prediction results with the real values.

Key words: Short-term load forecasting; Wavelet transform; AR model; Modulus maximum.

1. INTRODUCTION

Due to the randomness, volatility, and non stationarity of short-term electricity loads [1], the difficulty of short-term load forecasting is high. the traditional load forecasting methods for power systems mainly include trend extrapolation, regression analysis, time series analysis, wavelet analysis, and intelligent forecasting algorithms [2, 3]. the trend extrapolation method uses trend extrapolation technology to predict future loads, and its main feature is that it mainly targets historical data and requires relatively little data. the trend extrapolation prediction method can adapt to the trend of polynomials, and the method of using constant table accumulation can quickly determine the relationship. Simple calculation methods have strong practicality and are more suitable for short-term prediction [4]. Regression analysis method shows that the independent variable is a random factor and the dependent variable is a non random factor by analyzing the regression equation. Determine the relationship between each

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independent and dependent variable from multiple sets of data, and form a regression equation. After solving the regression equation, given the number of values for each variable, the value of the dependent variable can be found. Establish a predictive model based on regression analysis of historical data and some factors affecting load changes [5, 6]. The time series method analyzes and processes historical time series data to determine its basic characteristics and changing patterns, and predicts future loads by building mathematical models. the application of time series method in load forecasting takes a relatively long time. If the load series has high stability, using time series method can effectively improve the accuracy of load forecasting [7]. the wavelet analysis method can decompose signals in both time and frequency domains simultaneously, and can extract any details for different frequency components, which is very helpful for shortterm load prediction of power systems. It can extract any details of power loads and analyze the extracted detailed signals. the wavelet analysis method denoises short-term power load sequences and automatically processes the data during the wavelet decomposition process to obtain signals that remove false data, which can effectively improve prediction accuracy [8, 9]. Artificial intelligence algorithms, based on a large amount of load data, use intelligent algorithms such as genetic algorithm, particle swarm optimization algorithm, BP neural network, etc. to construct load forecasting models, adjust model parameters, and obtain short-term load forecasting results. This method has the advantages of short prediction time and low cost, but the prediction accuracy depends on whether the model and parameters are appropriate or not [10, 11, 12]. Based on the above analysis, this article adopts a prediction

algorithm combining wavelet transform and AR model to predict short-term loads. By obtaining short-term load historical data, the load curve is decomposed into high-frequency and low-frequency time series through wavelet decomposition. Then, the AR model is used to predict the decomposed subsequences, and the prediction results of each subsequence are reconstructed using wavelet to obtain the short-term load prediction values.

2 APPLICATION OF WAVELET TRANSFORM AND MALLAT ALGORITHM

Wavelet transform is a method of linear transformation [13], the wavelet function is described as: set $\Psi(t)$ as a square integrable function, namely $\Psi(t) \in L^2(R)$, If its Fourier transform $\Psi(\omega)$ satisfy permissibility conditions:

Among them, a, $b \in R$, alsoa $\neq 0$ Called aCalled the scaling factor, bIs the translation factor. Unlike the Fourier transform(project f(t) only into the frequency domain), Wavelet transform maps one-dimensional time-domain functions to two-dimensional f(t)"time-scale" Therefore, domains, expansion on wavelet basis has the characteristic of multi-resolution, which can perform multi-resolution decomposition on short-term load power series, and more clearly display the characteristics of each sequence of historical load data series at different frequencies.




Figure 1 Two extraction decomposition schematic diagram

The Mallat algorithm uses the wavelet decomposition process as an input signal

sequence for dual channel filtering processing, corresponding to filtering the low-frequency and high-frequency details of the input signal [14]. Due to the fact that the output signal length of the two filters is equal to the length of the original signal sequence, the total length obtained is twice the length of the original signal. Due to the frequency band of the original signal being divided into low-pass and high pass parts, the filtered output sequence is half of the original broadband signal. the power load signal sequence can be

separately filtered using low-pass filters H_0 and high pass filters H_1 decompose into lowfrequency parts of the frequency band from 0 to $\pi/2$ and the high-frequency part of the frequency band from $\pi/2$ to π . This method utilizes the multi-resolution decomposition of the original signal, which involves repeating the "double extraction" of its low-frequency part for each decomposition. Two extraction decomposition is shown in Figure 1.

Wherein: $C_{j,k}$ is a scale coefficient, $d_{j,k}$ is a wavelet coefficient, $\downarrow 2$ is down sampling. Wavelet analysis has special local time-frequency characteristics, and we can use different frequency components to gradually clarify the sampling steps. the wavelet transform method can decompose the original short-term load data into different frequency bands, and present the signal characteristics of historical load sequences more clearly in different frequency bands. We can preprocess signals at different frequencies to eliminate abrupt signals in the signal, Eliminate noise on the signal. the signals at various frequencies have a certain degree of stability, and the time

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series method can be used to predict signals at various frequency bands.




Figure 2 Time series prediction model flowchart

Wavelet transform is the process of selecting orthogonal wavelets to project the original load onto different scales. Each original sequence is composed of different "frequency domains", clearly indicating the load sequence. We can use the time series method to predict the decomposed time series separately, and then perform wavelet reconstruction on the predicted results of each series to obtain the final load forecasting result. the flowchart of the prediction model is shown in Figure 2.




Figure 3 Original load time series

The sub sequences obtained after wavelet transform have a certain periodicity, and a3 is a low-frequency coefficient that contains the most useful load information. D1 is a highfrequency coefficient that contains a lot of random load information and has high volatility. Therefore, before predicting the load of d1 high-frequency coefficient, it is necessary to eliminate the linear trend term in the time series of the load data. D2 and d3 mainly represent the daily fluctuation of power load. Using the samples from March 1st to March 30th in a certain county, the load samples were decomposed at three scales


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using db4 wavelet. the scale map of the wavelet transform for multi-resolution analysis is shown in Figure 3.

3 VERIFICATION OF LOAD FORECASTING SIMULATION MODEL Use db4 wavelet decomposition coefficients

to predict the load value on the last day of the month.

The low-frequency coefficient a3 adopts a daily load cycle and is predicted by the AR model. the predicted values are shown in Figure 4.




Figure 5 Predicted value of d3

The high-frequency coefficient d3 represents the daily load cycle, and the predicted value through the AR model is shown in Figure 5.




Figure 6 The predicted value of d2

The high-frequency coefficient d2 is selected as a load with a daily cycle, and predicted by the AR model. the predicted values are shown in Figure 6.




Figure 7 The predicted value of d1

The high-frequency coefficient d1 is selected as a load with a daily cycle, and predicted by the AR model. the predicted values are shown in Figure 7.




Figure 8 Predicted load and actual load curve chart

Compare the predicted value on the last day of the month with the actual historical data, and the comparison of the predicted load and actual load curves is shown in Figure 8.




Figure 9 Error between predicted value and actual value

By comparing the error between the predicted value and the actual value, Figure 9 is obtained.

4. CONCLUSION

This article combines wavelet transform with AR model to carry out short-term load forecasting. By utilizing the excellent timefrequency characteristics of wavelet transform, non-stationary time series are decomposed into stationary time series are decomposed into stationary time series through wavelet decomposition. Then, through AR model prediction and wavelet reconstruction, the

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results of short-term load forecasting are obtained.

Compared with the actual value, the 24-hour load prediction results have a prediction error of less than 5%, high prediction accuracy, and good prediction results, which have high engineering application value.

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
